Site response activities continue at Cambridge Station.

- Groundwater samples were collected for analysis from the remaining unsampled temporary wells installed during the sub-surface investigation last week.
- Initial geotechnical soil samples were collected from undisturbed onsite soils to support future remediation efforts.
- Excavation backfill is underway along with the installation of remedial infrastructure to support future remediation efforts.
- Waste Disposal:
  - A total of 2912 tons of oily soils/debris have been disposed of at WM Deer Track Park Landfill in Watertown, WI.
  - 4000 gallons of oily water (<1% oil) was disposed of at Reworld in Hodgkins, IL.</li>
    - Approximately 1000 gallons of oil was recovered from the oily water and returned to the pipeline system.
- Private water well analytical results were received for two residential wells that were sampled on 12/13/2024 (W8489 Hwy 18 and W8292 Hwy 18).
- Enbridge met with WDNR staff to provide a site status update and discuss path forward for the site on 12/19/2024.
- WNDR and USEPA completed a site visit on 12/20/2024.
