- WAM Contractor Services: Program administered by the DNR to fund Phase I & II Environmental Site Assessments, Site Investigations and/or remedial action planning at Brownfield sites throughout Wisconsin. The services are provided via Contractor Services, in which DNR contracted environmental contractors perform the environmental assessment work. As we mentioned, the requirements to apply are an application, signed access agreement and municipal resolution, which are on the DNR webpage and attached for your convenience. Given the history of the site using petroleum products, I've attached a Determination of Viable Responsible Party attachment that should be filled out and included with your WAM application submittal. As was mentioned, WAM services are provided at no cost to the WAM applicant.

 If the applicant owns the property at the time of the lean they may be eligible for lean

If the applicant owns the property at the time of the loan they may be eligible for loan forgiveness. Loan forgiveness functions as a grant and the applicant must own the property for the entire loan period. The property may be transferred after the loan period has ended. Loans are interest free and payback terms can be flexible (e.g. up to 10-year timeframe). As mentioned during the call, there's a 22% match required under the R4R program.
