Pursuant to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) e-mail communication dated May 16, 2018, regarding the Ramboll Case Closure Request dated December 6, 2017, this letter provides estimated costs to abandon groundwater monitoring wells and soil vapor monitoring wells at and adjacent to the 910 Elm Grove Road property. Specifically, twelve 2-inch diameter groundwater monitoring wells located at 890 Elm Grove Road, 910 Elm Grove Road, and 930 Elm Grove Road, one 1-inch diameter groundwater monitoring well located at 13435 Watertown Plank Road, and two 1-inch diameter soil vapor monitoring wells located at 930 Elm Grove Road will be abandoned. The wells will be abandoned in conformance with Wisconsin Administrative Code Chapter NR 141, followed by preparation and submittal of well abandonment forms to the WDNR. Access agreements with off-site property owners will be updated as necessary to complete the well abandonments. Estimated costs to complete these activities are summarized as follows:

Senior Manager: 3 hours @ \$150 per hour	\$450
