The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) received the above "Groundwater Remedial Action Options Memorandum Addendum" dated May 6, 2021 and the "Technical Memorandum-Responses to DNR Questions" dated August 3, 2021 from KPRG. The DNR reviews environmental investigation and remediation cases for compliance with state statutes and rules to maintain consistency in the investigation and remediation of these cases. After review of the above report, DNR is conditionally approving the Interim Action with the conditions listed below, however additional remedial activities may be required to decrease the groundwater concentrations on and off-site.

- 1. Install a monitoring well and piezometer west of well MW-39 and south of the new apartment building. These wells will be used to monitor VOC concentrations during and after the injection event.
- 2. Install a piezometer downgradient of the Navistar site to better define the horizontal extent of the groundwater contamination. Propose a location west of the Navistar site (maybe near MW-36). Additional piezometers may be needed depending on the sampling results.
- 3. Additional persulfate sampling\monitoring should be completed every 2 days (same as other indicator Parameters) to monitor movement of the injected material into the groundwater.
- 4. Provide a Remedial Documentation Report after the groundwater injection is complete. Additional remedial activities may be required based on the results of this Interim Action.
- 5. Submit the injection approval request and WPDES permit application.
