The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) received the above "South Parking Lot Remedial Action Completion Documentation", dated April 20, 2022, from KPRG. The DNR reviews environmental investigation and remediation cases for compliance with state statutes and rules to maintain consistency in the investigation and remediation of these cases. After review of the above report DNR is providing the following comments:

### Interim Action Soil Removal

During November 2021, a total of 3,584 tons of TCE impacted soil present to the water table was removed from the parking lot property. Confirmation soil samples were collected after excavation. DNR is approving the Interim Action for the parking lot, however residual soil impacts are present at the water table.

## **Groundwater Investigation**

Additional groundwater sampling is required in the area. A stable or reducing groundwater contamination plume is required before site closure can be granted.

<u>Until the site investigation and closure requirements have been met, your site will remain "open" and you also will need to continue to submit the semi-annual progress reports, as required by s. NR 711(1), Wis. Adm. Code.</u>
