Eric, thank you for the updated drawing. Matt and I discussed, and the plan that we would like to proceed with is as follows:

- W19 – Abandon
- W33 – No impacts except sidewalk removal, well can remain in place
- W39 – Abandon
- W22 – No impacts we can keep this well location.
- W40 – Move east due to proposed driveway. This will be a flush mount well
- W26 – Relocate to north side of sidewalk, rather than between curb and south side of sidewalk. Recommend this be a stick-up well.
- W29 – Relocate to north side of sidewalk, rather than between curb and south side of sidewalk. Recommend this be a stick-up well.

Regarding locating flush mount wells in the future, TRC can assist the City in locating these wells, and then what is typically done as work is performed around them, is to place cones and/or barrels over the wells to alert equipment operators of their presence. Hi Bruce/Matt,

Please find attached proposed locations for the monitoring wells we discussed. There are a couple of them we feel can stay:

- W19 – Relocate to south terrace
- W33 – No impacts except sidewalk removal can remain in place
- W39 – Relocate to terrace on Cleveland Bypass
- W22 – No impacts we can keep this location.
- W40 – Needs to move east due to proposed driveway
- W26 – Relocate to north terrace
- W29 – Relocation to north terrace

There was discussion about flush mounted wells, the city would prefer this but I am wondering who would be responsible for locating these in the future if excavation work was to take place in the ROW? How have you handled this in other areas? The wells not moving can remain as they are. Thanks Bruce.
