Dear Mr. McClure:

I received Shannon & Wilson, Inc.'s (S&W) "Sediment Remediation Work Plan and Contained out Hazardous Waste Determination Request" (plan) for the DB Oak Facility, 700-710 Oak Street, Fort Atkinson, on March 15, 2017. The request was accompanied by the appropriate review fee, required under ch. NR 749, Wisconsin Administrative Code.

In the plan, S&W concludes the sediment contamination in the downstream drainage swale borings are not hazardous waste, and that the sediment can be handled as solid waste during the remediation effort. The department concurs with this determination. The concentrations of chlorinated solvents detected in the leaching test for the most contaminated boring were below the 'contained out' values listed on Table 2 of the plan. The available knowledge of the site history and waste source also qualify the material to be 'contained out'.

During implementation of the plan, all material handling, removal, and disposal must be done in accordance with state and federal rules. This includes proper handling and disposal of all water from sediment dewatering.

This approval does not cover the adequacy of the remediation plan, only the approach and the contained-out status of the known contamination. S&W did not include a map showing the sediment sample locations or the proposed boundaries of excavation in the plan, so it is not possible to comment on the comprehensiveness of the effort. In addition, any material that is significantly more contaminated than what has been encountered may require additional waste characterization to assure the disposal rules are met.

Please have S&W proceed with the planning and implementation, and have them contact me with the schedule for so I may have an opportunity to observe the work.
