Hello John.

As planned, we will be commencing the SWL&P Pre-Design Investigation (PDI) sampling efforts this coming Monday, July 6th.

Due to shallow (less than 3 feet) water depths in the southeastern corner of the boat slip, we have been working with Coleman Engineering (our drilling contractor) and SWL&P to make some adjustments to the PDI sediment scope that account for these field conditions and meet the

objectives of the PDI.

The planned modifications to the scope are outlined in the attached memorandum. Please reach out to any or all of those copied on this email if you have any questions or concerns.

We understand that you won't be able to join us in the field for any of the fieldwork due to COVID restrictions, correct? If that changes, please know you are welcome. In the meantime, we shall keep you apprised of our progress and findings along the way.
