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Hi Trent and John,

Thank you for the follow-up Trent, I did get your phone message too.

The recent submittal doesn't meet the requirements of NR 716.14(2) (a). Specifically...

(a) The report to the department shall include a preliminary analysis of the cause and significance of any contaminant concentrations observed in the sample, a list of names and addresses of those receiving a sampling notification, and the date of the sampling event and mailing.

You will need to make the necessary additions. I recommend reviewing NR 716.14 requirements to assure full compliance.

I appreciate the extenuating circumstance of the pandemic and hope things are better now, but I do need to remind you both that failure to meet s. NR 716.14, Wis. Adm. Code requirements was cited in the September 23, 2019 notice of non-compliance sent to Denver Gardner. In the future, FEC and Gardner Denver should be more communicative when it comes to difficulties complying with the rules.

I have questions and comments about FEC's sampling workplan commitments.

Page 3 states, "Two additional rounds of groundwater sampling will be conducted on all new and existing wells for CVOCs."

- 1. It appears not all wells were sampled (e.g. the TW- series wells.), why not?
- 2. When will you perform the next round of sampling?

Page 4 states, "FEC will provide the results of the testing to the DNR to comply with the 10-day notice."

1. You acknowledged that you did not meet the 10-day notice. The results (missing the items noted above) were supplied to the department about 50 days past the 10-day timeline.

Page 4 states, "We will also provide verbal reports, as information is available, to keep you updated regarding the status of the project."

2. We have not received any verbal reports; you may meet this commitment by email. A good time to use this option is when you encounter problems or have unforeseen delays.
