Dear Mr. Danko and Mr. Wahl:

On May 27, 2020, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) directed Johnson Controls, Inc. and Tyco Fire Products LP (JCI/Tyco) to take immediate actions to address foam on waterways in the city of Marinette (Marinette) and the town of Peshtigo (Peshtigo) as part of open site investigations regarding discharges of per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) at the JCI/Tyco Stanton Street Campus (BRRTS# 02-38-581955) and the JCI/Tyco Fire Technology Center (BRRTS #02-38-580694).

Based on the findings from the immediate actions implemented by JCI/Tyco to date, additional response actions are required per Wis. Admin. Code § NR 708.07 to address reoccurring accumulations of foam in waterways in the Marinette and Peshtigo areas. JCI/Tyco is directed to submit a Foam Response Plan (Plan) to the DNR by February 15, 2021 for review and approval. The Plan must describe the following:

- Plan and schedule to inspect waterways for foam accumulations
- List of waterways to be inspected and criteria for selection
- Description of response actions and criteria for when action(s) will be taken
- Plan for management of waste, including characterization, temporary storage, and disposal
- Description of record keeping and documentation to be completed
- Plan for reporting to DNR that complies with the requirements of ch. NR 708 Wis. Admin. Code.

As a reminder, this site is subject to an enforcement action and therefore all submittals to the DNR under Wis. Admin. Code chs. NR 700-799 and submittals directed by the DNR must be accompanied by an Wis. Admin. Code ch. NR 749 fee per Wis. Stat. § 292.94. These fees are not pro-ratable or refundable per Wis. Admin. Code § NR 749.04(1). If you have any questions about whether to include a fee with a submittal, please contact DNR staff prior to submitting a document without a fee.
