Jeff and Scott –

On September 20, 2021, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) received Johnson Controls, Inc. and Tyco Fire Products' LP (JCI/Tyco's) [Proposed Modification to Foam Management Plan](#). We have reviewed your plan to reduce the frequency of inspections for foam in the ditches from daily to weekly. The DNR concurs with JCI/Tyco's plan for weekly monitoring in Ditches A, C, D, and E. However, for Ditch B the routine inspections should occur at least twice per week (i.e., once every 3 to 5 days).

It is expected that if foam observations are reported to JCI/Tyco by others in the community prior to a routine inspection of areas addressed by the Foam Monitoring Plan, that JCI/Tyco will respond without delay to collect the foam and that daily inspections will resume where foam was sighted until foam was not observed again for 3 consecutive days.

Please note that the DNR's March 17, 2021 approval letter requires that other surface water locations found to have foam accumulations containing PFAS, which are within the extent of impacts from JCI/Tyco's sites, must be added to the foam monitoring program in the future. The frequency for monitoring other surface water locations for foam will be made on a case-by-case basis.
