Jeff - Thank you for notifying the DNR that management of contaminated materials associated with construction of the groundwater extraction and treatment system (GETS) for BRRTS #02-38-580694 will extend beyond July 31, 2022.

The DNR approves this second request to continue managing the contaminated soil through September 30, 2022 in accordance with the <u>Materials Management Plan (MMP)</u> and the requirements specified in the <u>DNR's October 6, 2021 Approval Letter</u>. (The DNR's approval of the first request for an extension is attached).

The DNR also agrees with the plan to wait until the GETS is fully operational to treat the contaminated water generated during construction of the GETS, and understands that this means that the water management specified in the MMP may extent through December 31, 2022.

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Alyssa,

On January 20, 2022, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources approved the "Groundwater Extraction and Treatment System – Interim Remedial Action Materials Management Plan, WI DNR BRRTS Activity #: 02-38-580694" (MMP) request for extension through July 31, 2022. Water generated during system construction and well development is currently stored in frac tanks at the Fire Technology Center property. Any additional water generated during system testing will also be stored in frac tanks on the Fire Technology property until it can be treated through the GETS system. Due to further delays with supply chain, COVID-19 constraints, and GETS construction startup testing, water management will continue beyond July 31, 2022; therefore, we are requesting an extension through December 31, 2022, for water management.

Soil that is not being managed on site is currently being transported off-site for disposal. We expect soil removal to be complete by September 30, 2022; therefore, we are requesting an extension through September 30, 2022 for soil management.

Please confirm the WDNR approves the extension request.
