I understand about the per diems.

Yes, on the old wells, whatever test you run, we will only reimburse the PVOC+Naph cost.

I am not the project manager for this site, so I can't say what will be required. I know that VOCs will need to be run at some point in order to close out the ERP site portion. To be able to get it done for the reduced cost (VOC cost minus the PVOC+Naph reimbursement) is a really good deal for your client. I hope he sees it that way.
