The DNR has reviewed your submittal *Tyco Fire Products LP, Stanton Street Property NR 718 Location Standards Exemption Request*, dated May 19, 2023. The location standards exemption request cannot be approved at this time for the following reasons:

- Under Wis. Admin. Code ch. NR 718, a separate materials management plan (MMP) must be submitted for individual activities. Form 4400-315, Recommended Template for a Request to Manage Materials under Wis. Admin. Code § NR 718.12 or 718.15 facilitates this process and can be submitted with other requests, depending on the activities being proposed at the site. When submitting an MMP, Tyco must consider other requirements of the site's soil/material management plan (currently under development).
- A singular waste profile is not acceptable for all activities at the site. The heterogeneous nature of fill and soil at the site and history of contamination require a waste determination for each activity.

We recognize that the location of the site, within a floodplain, adjacent to a wetland and river, and persistent high groundwater table, will require a location exemption request with each activity. However, there are options to address the risks associated with management of contaminated soil that can be approved.
