Subject: 3M RCRA PFAS Site in Wausau

Hi Peter,

I'm a Superfund remedial project manager and I'm reaching out because one of my Superfund Sites, Wausau Groundwater Contamination, has municipal wells with PFOA and

PFOS above MCLs even after ion exchange resin treatment. The Site includes the City's municipal wells and there's data to suggest that the Site is one source of these PFAS. However, there is also a 3M RCRA facility (Greystone in Wausau Wisconsin) that's only 2 miles upgradient from the municipal wells. The 3M facility has known groundwater PFAS contamination (See [this article](#) for details).

Do you or a project manager in your section happen to know if RCRA is aware or addressing any of the PFAS contamination at that particular 3M Site? I've reached out to folks in Wisconsin in case the Site is being addressed by their R/R program, but I haven't heard from them quite yet. Any information would be very helpful!
