Jennifer and Kristin,

Just so you know what we are doing:

We resampled the soil from the three boxes that had high PCE and/or failed TCLP last week. They were sampled on Dec 8, and the lab has been holding them prior to analysis approval from us. We have authorized the lab to run the following analyses:

1) Treated soil I1 B

2) Treated Soil K1 B

Run those two for Total VOC's

3) Treated soil QB

Run this one for TCLP VOCs and Total VOCs

Hurry up analysis - results by Friday would be good -

If the treated soil from these two boxes pass the criteria now - it would be because the treatment had a longer time period to react.

I still need a fast decision on the soil, regardless of these results, but thought it might be good to get this started without further delay - we'll need more data from box Q regardless.
