## EXHIBIT A

### Written Determination by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources

1. A Notice of Contamination (Deed Notice) was recorded at the Register of Deeds in Marquette County, Wisconsin, on November 28, 2006, as Document No. 266678. It applies to the property located at N3475 CO RD/CTH M, Town of Packwaukee, Wisconsin (Property) which is owned by James and Joan Barker (Barkers).
2. The Deed Notice issued under Wis. Admin. Code § NR 728.11, by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) was to notify any purchaser of the existence and potential liability of petroleum contamination associated with ownership of the Property. The DNR in accordance with Wisconsin Administrative Code and Wis. Stat. § 292.11(3) determined all administrative and statutory obligations for this release of contamination, had not been met. Because the DNR believed petroleum contamination would continue to release into the environment, it was necessary to notify subsequent purchasers of the Property of contamination for which they could be liable.
3. A gas station and service garage operated on the Property until approximately the early 1970's. Three underground storage tanks (USTs) were installed at the Property for retail use, a 1,000 gallon UST containing diesel fuel, and two USTs containing gasoline (one 1,500 gallon and one 500 gallon). These tanks were removed by the Marell Inc. on November 5, 1992. Marell Inc. collected a soil sample beneath the 1,000 gallon UST and confirmed the presence of petroleum contamination in soil. METCO environmental was ultimately retained and on January 27, 2014, submitted a site investigation report meeting all requirements under Wis. Admin. Code § NR 716.15. The Northeast Region (NER) closure committee reviewed a request for closure on May 2, 2019, and approved case closure with continuing obligations. On July 23, 2019, the site was administratively closed.
4. Thus, at this time, with the information available, the referenced release of contamination at the Property is determined to meet all administrative and statutory obligations regarding Wisconsin Administrative Code and Wis. Stat. § 292.11(3). Please refer to the final closure letter dated July 23, 2019, for the list of continuing obligations which currently exist at the Property located at, N3475 CO RD/CTH M, Town of Packwaukee, Wisconsin.
5. Therefore, the environmental contamination previously identified on this Property has been adequately addressed. The DNR believes the need for the previously filed Notice of Contamination has been satisfied.
