- 2. Dee Lance, Hydrogeologist, of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, West Central Regional Office has personal knowledge of the facts herein set forth and believe the same to be true.
- 3. The department was notified of a petroleum contamination discharge at the property located at 3407 Sherman Street, Town of Stettin, County of Marathon, and which has the above legal description.
- 4. The removal or treatment of the contamination is required on the property under the authority of Wis. Stats. § 292.11.
- 5. On November 15, 2019 the department sent a letter, by certified mail, to Rib River Developers, to the attention of Shane Rader, 3301 Sherman St., Wausau, Wisconsin, advising of the statutory requirement to restore the environment at that location, and that a notice of contamination may be recorded if satisfactory action to restore the environment did not commence. That letter requested a written response within 30 days from the date the letter was received. No response to that letter was received by the department, by December 15, 2019.
- On February 6 2020, the department sent a second letter, by certified mail, to Rib River Developers, to the attention of Shane Rader, 3301 Sherman St., Wausau, Wisconsin, advising that the department has made the decision to record a notice of contamination for the above-described property at the county Register of Deeds office. The 30-day deadline specified in the letter has expired. The 15 day waiting period since that deadline, required by Wis. Adm. Code § NR728.11 (2)(c), has passed without an acceptable response.
