
I, Roxanne N. Chronert, being first duly sworn, state that:

1. I am a Remediation and Redevelopment Program Supervisor, employed by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (hereinafter referred as "DNR") at its Northeast Regional Office.
2. I have personal knowledge of the facts herein set forth and believe the same to be true.
3. The confirmed release of Petroleum Volatile Organic Compounds (PVOCs) at the above-described property, for which the DNR recorded a Notice of Contamination Affidavit (Affidavit) on September 8, 2000, as document number 1105590, has been investigated and remediated to the satisfaction of DNR. The residual contamination, originating at the property described above, does not exceed state standards and there is no longer an imminent threat to human health or the environment. As a result, a No Further Action (NFA) letter was issued by DNR on September 1, 2016.
4. In accordance with Wis. Admin. Code § NR 728.11(3), on September 1, 2016, the NFA letter to the property owner, Mr. Thomas L. Lemke, stated that a second Deed Notice which shall supersede the original Affidavit for the above-described property, could be recorded at the Winnebago County Register of Deeds office.



