Under s. 292.81 (3), Wis. Stats., when the Department expends funds to investigate and remove hazardous substance contamination, the Department may file a lien for the amount expended for such purposes with the Register of Deeds in the county where the contaminated property is located.

The amount expended by the Department in this case is Nineteen Thousand Three Hundred Ninety Four Dollars and fifty two cents (\$19,394.52). The property remains subject to this lien until the amount owed is paid in full. This lien is superior to all other liens that are or have been filed against the property, except that if the property is residential property as defined in s. 895.52 (1)(I), Wis. Stats., the lien does not affect any valid prior lien, as defined in s. 292.81(1), Wis. Stats., on that residential property.

The Department certifies that to the best of its knowledge and belief, all information contained in this Lien is correct and this lien represents a legal encumbrance upon the property. Based on the above information and the authority of s. 292.81 (3), Wis. Stats., the Department claims a lien against the interest which the owner(s) have in the above described property in the amount of \$ 19.394.52.
