

All applicants for financial assistance through the Environmental Improvement Fund (EIF) shall submit land ownership and easements documentation as authorized under ss. NR 162.055 and NR 166.09, Wis. Adm. Code. Failure to submit a completed certification form or legal opinion before the loan closing will result in denial of EIF funds for the project.

Note: A recipient is not required to submit a land ownership and easement rights certification form for portions of a project that include removal of lead service lines or galvanized pipe on private property.
