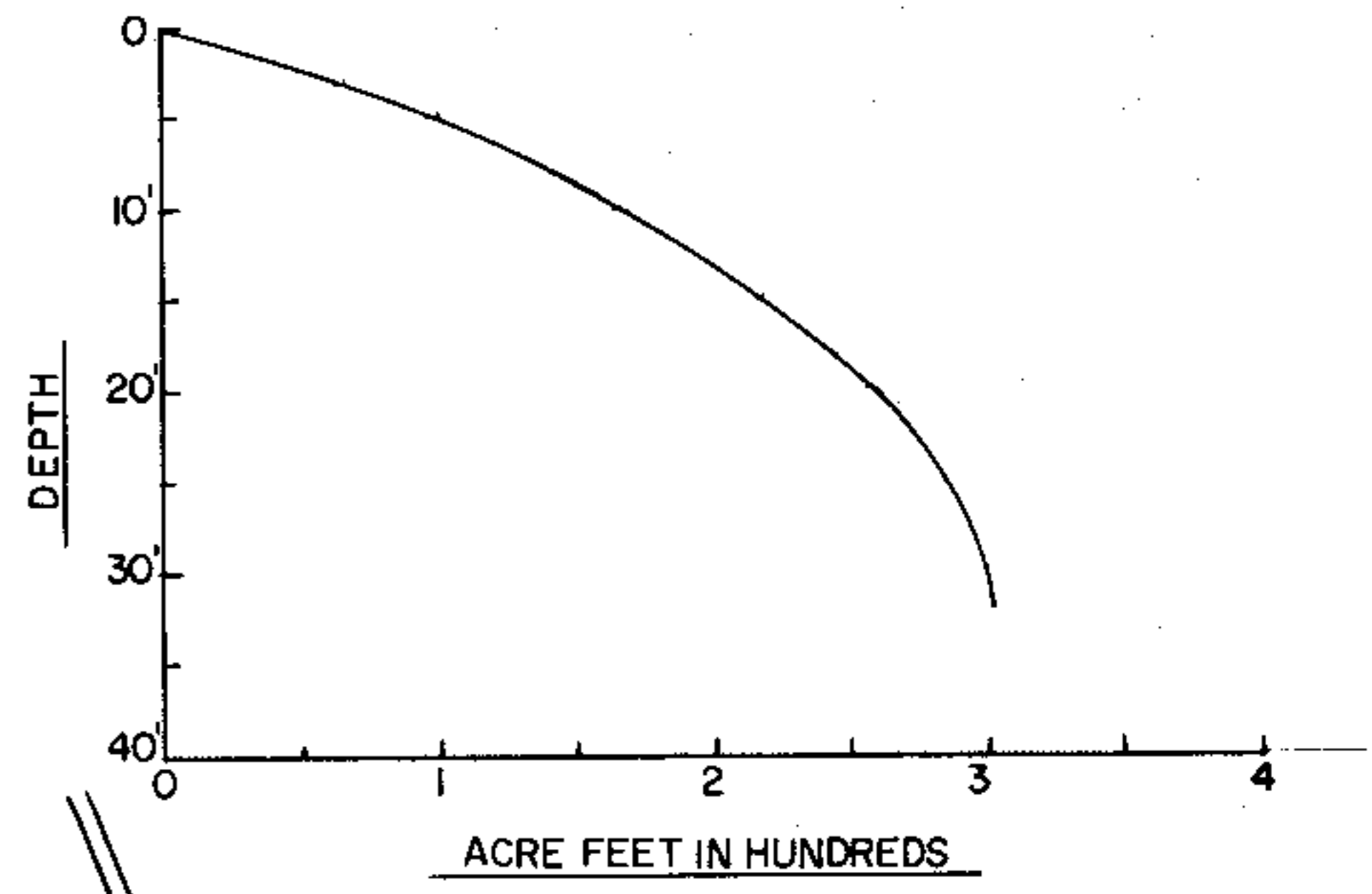
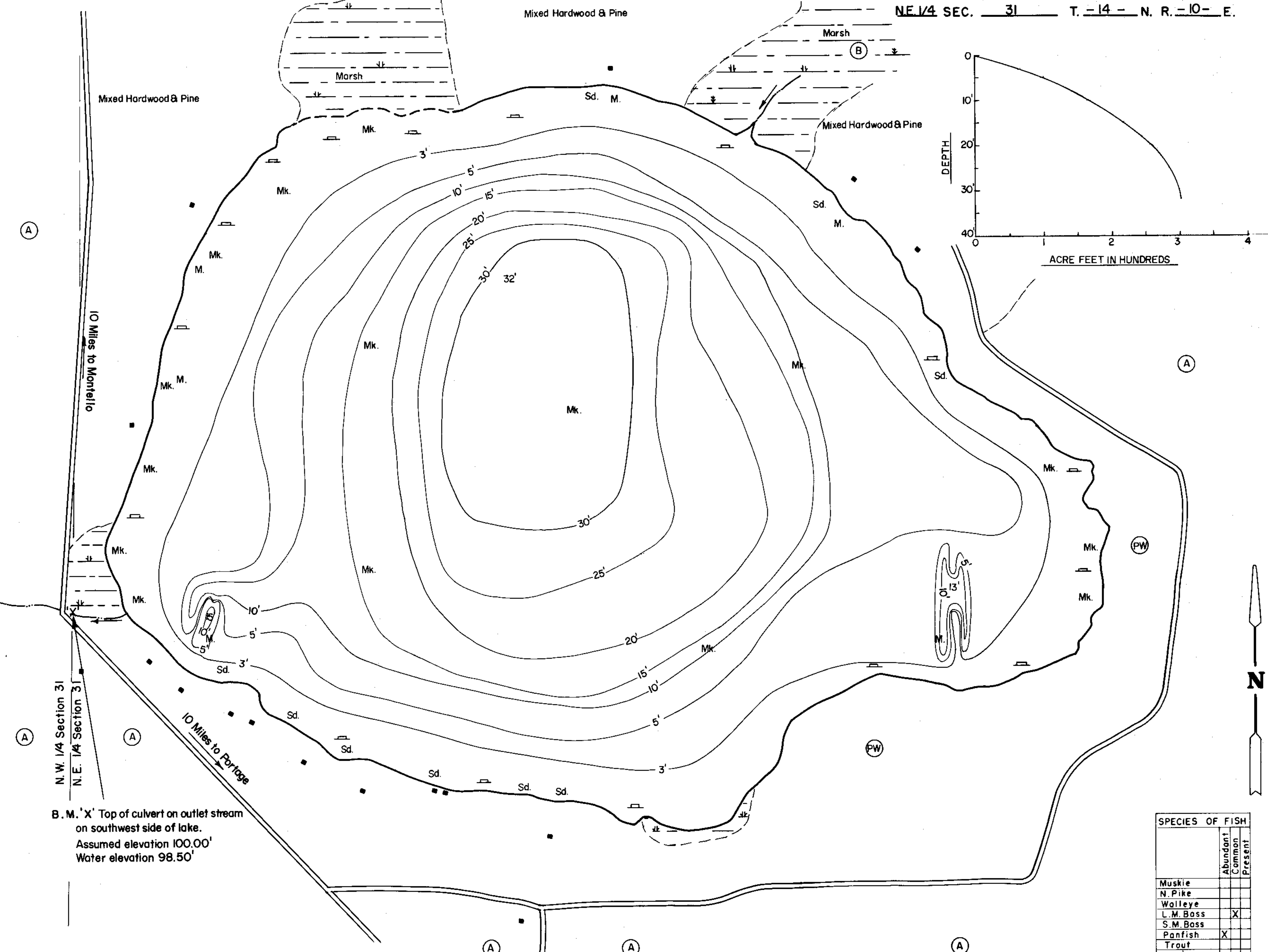


LAKE SURVEY MAP

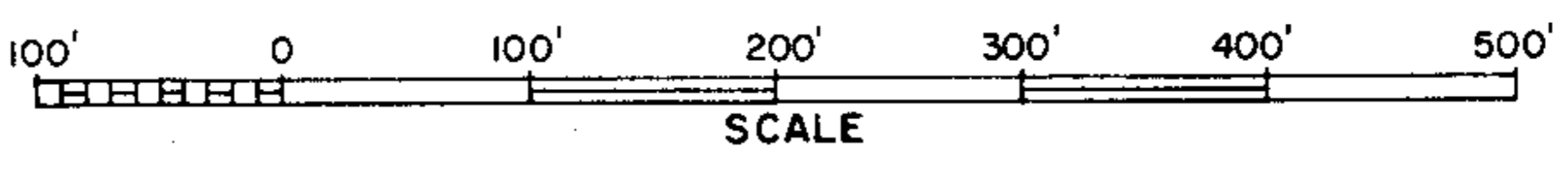


B.M. 'X' Top of culvert on outlet stream on southwest side of lake.
