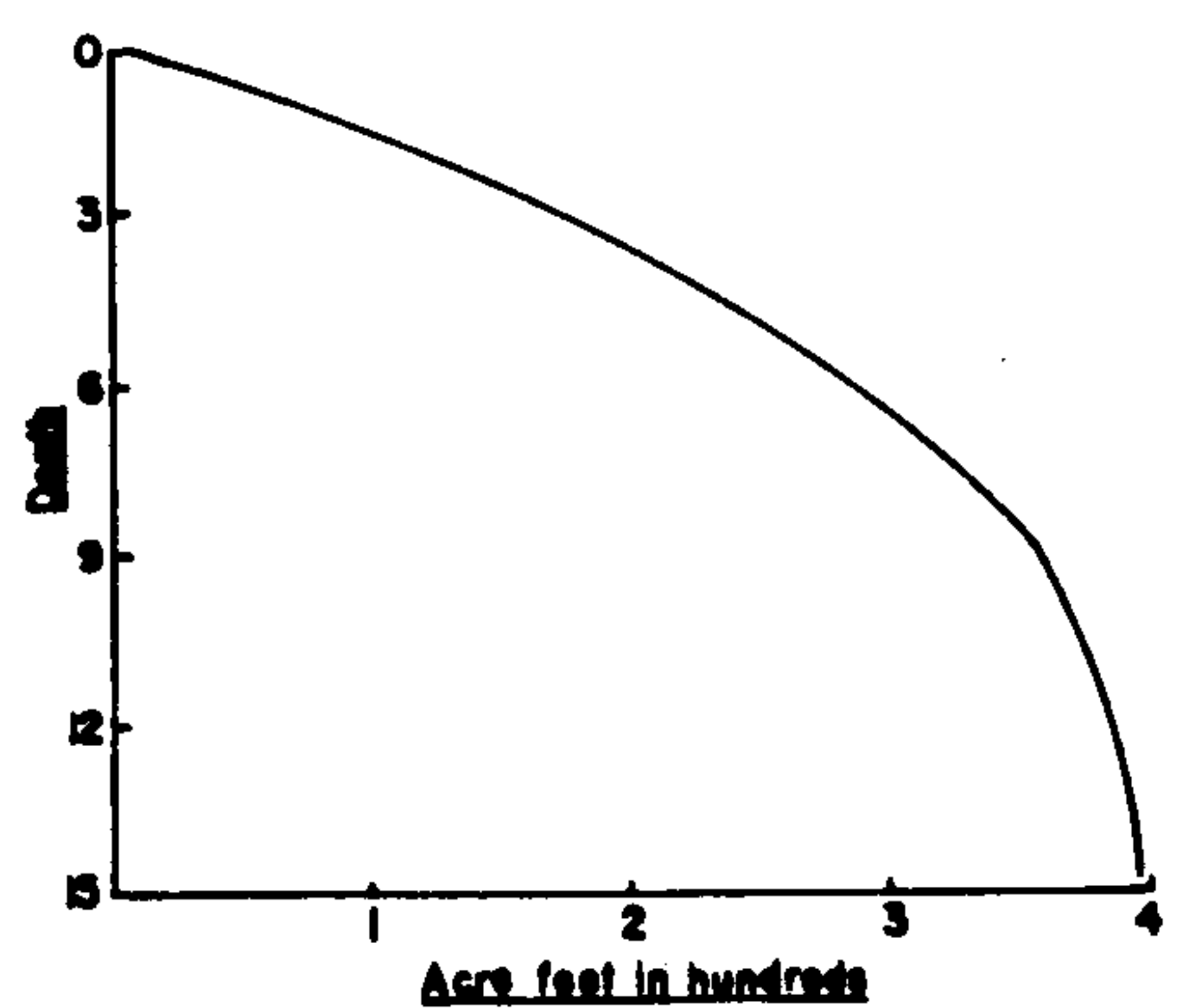


Bench mark (X) - 3 spikes driven into red oak tree 1' above ground - south side of access.
