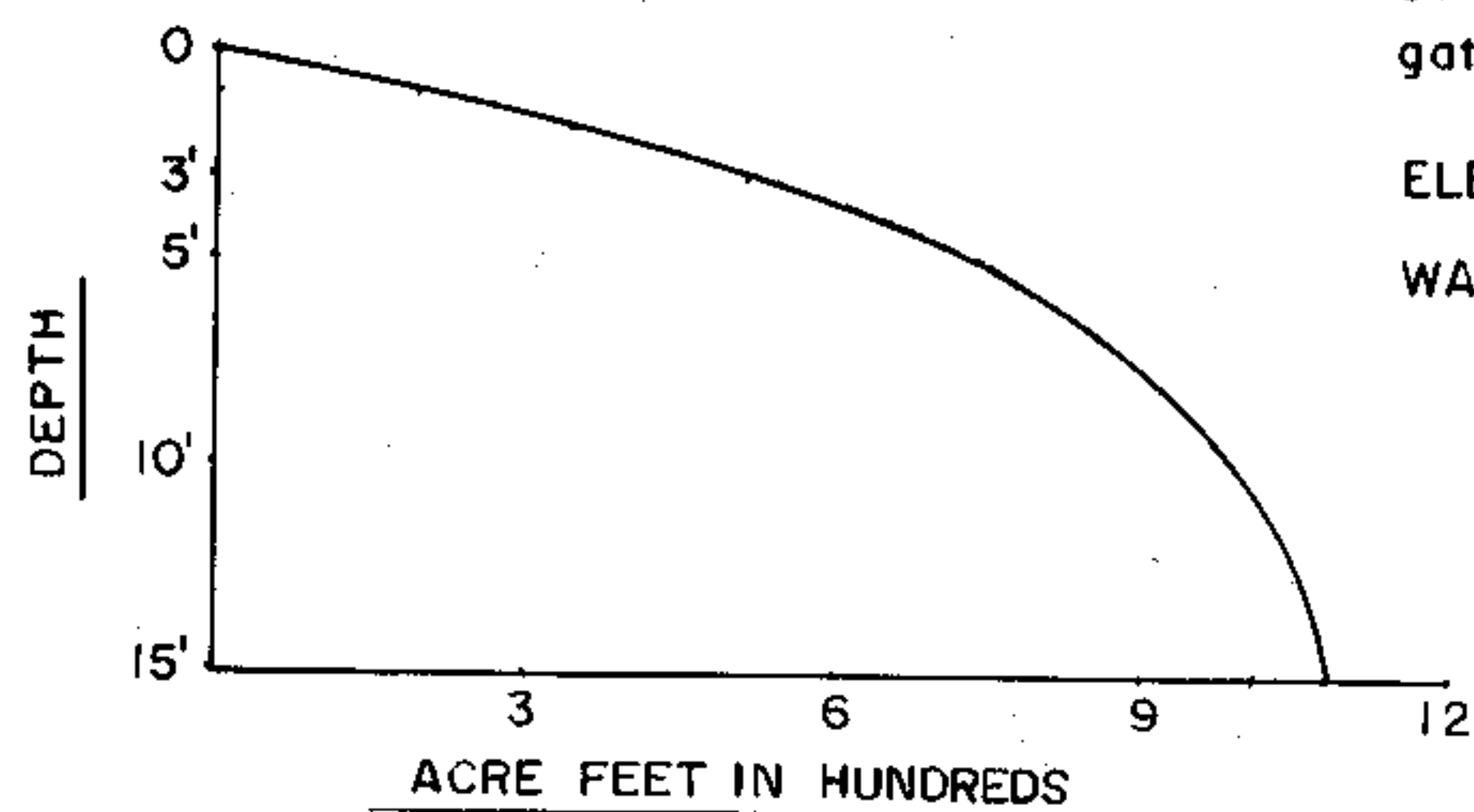


DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES B.M.-129F,
