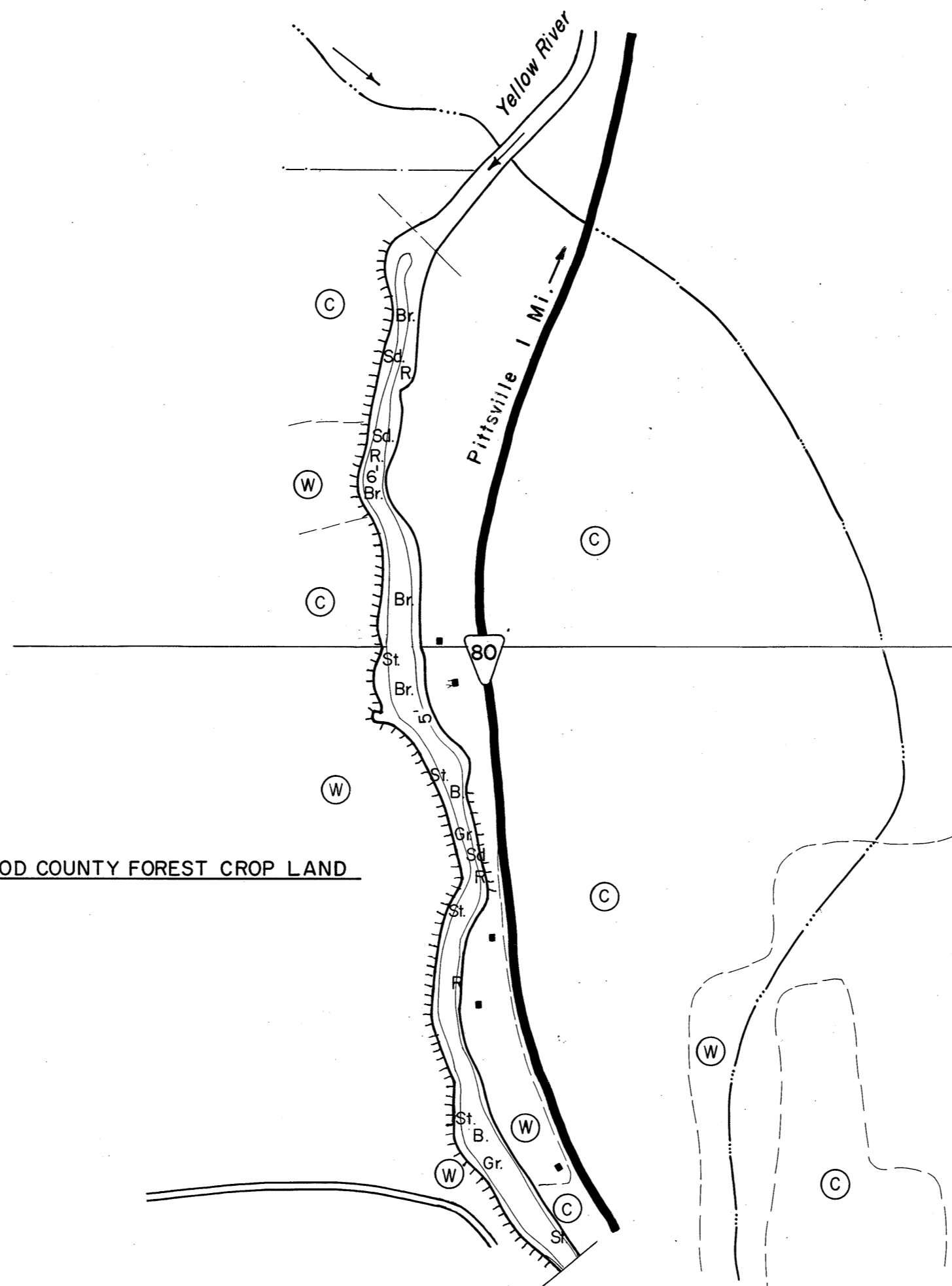
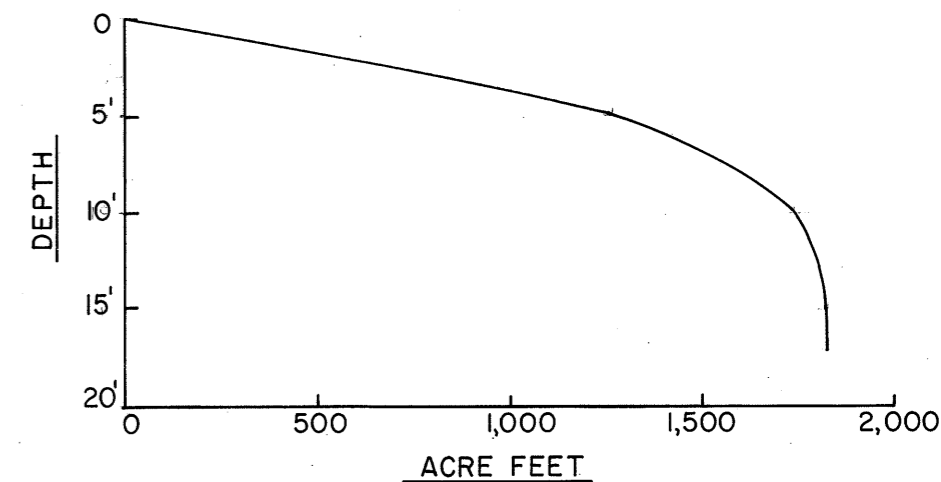


LAKE SURVEY MAP

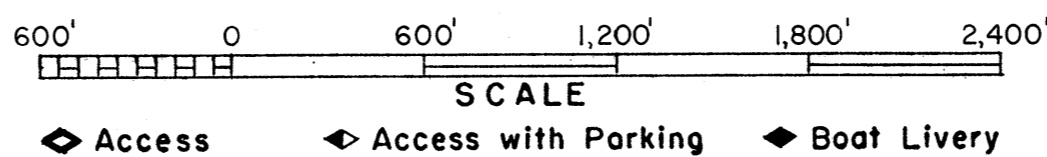

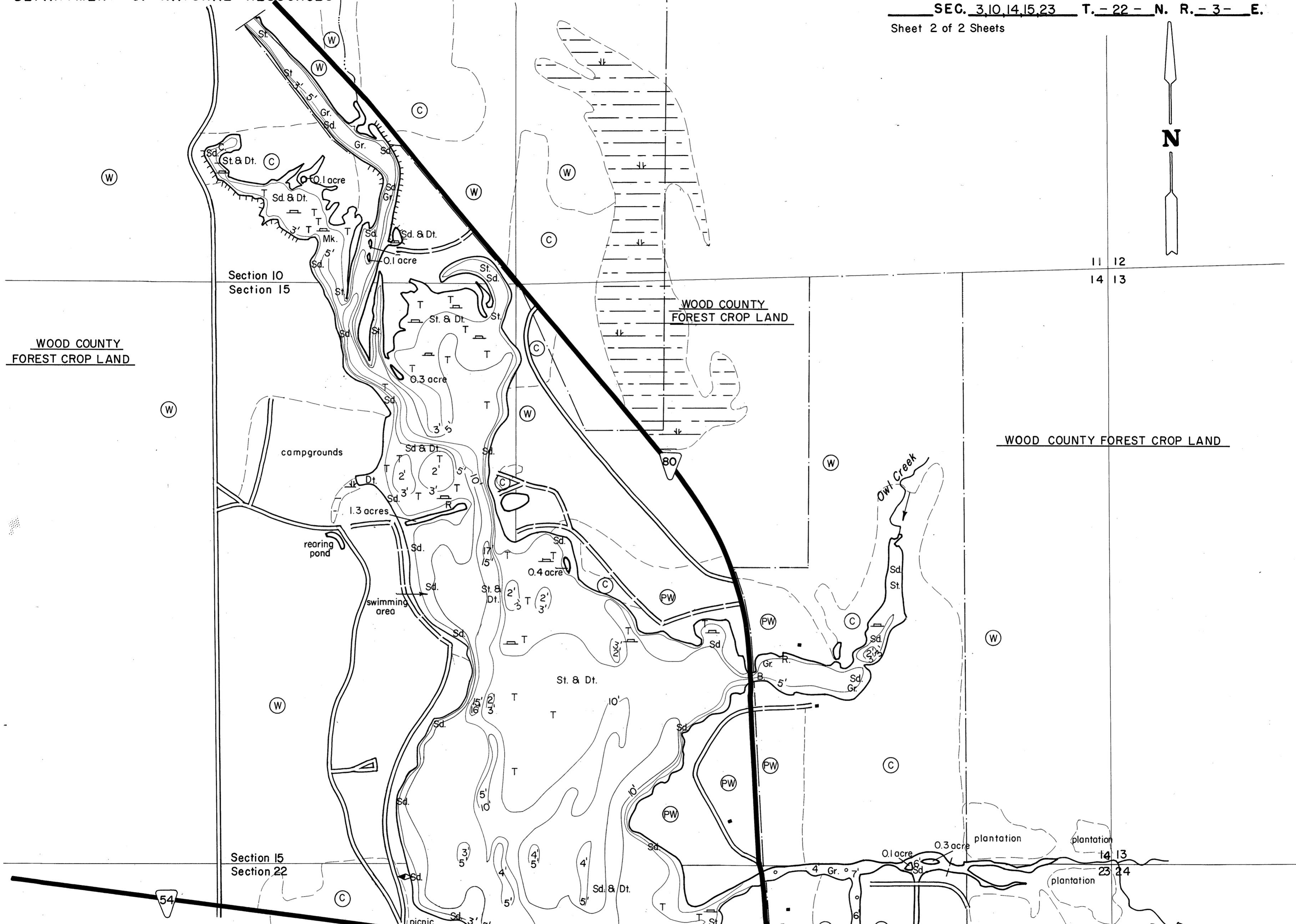
