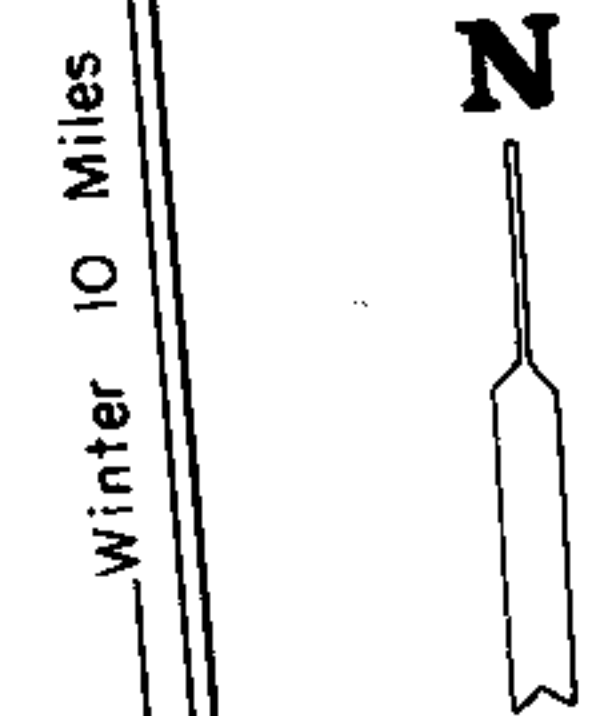
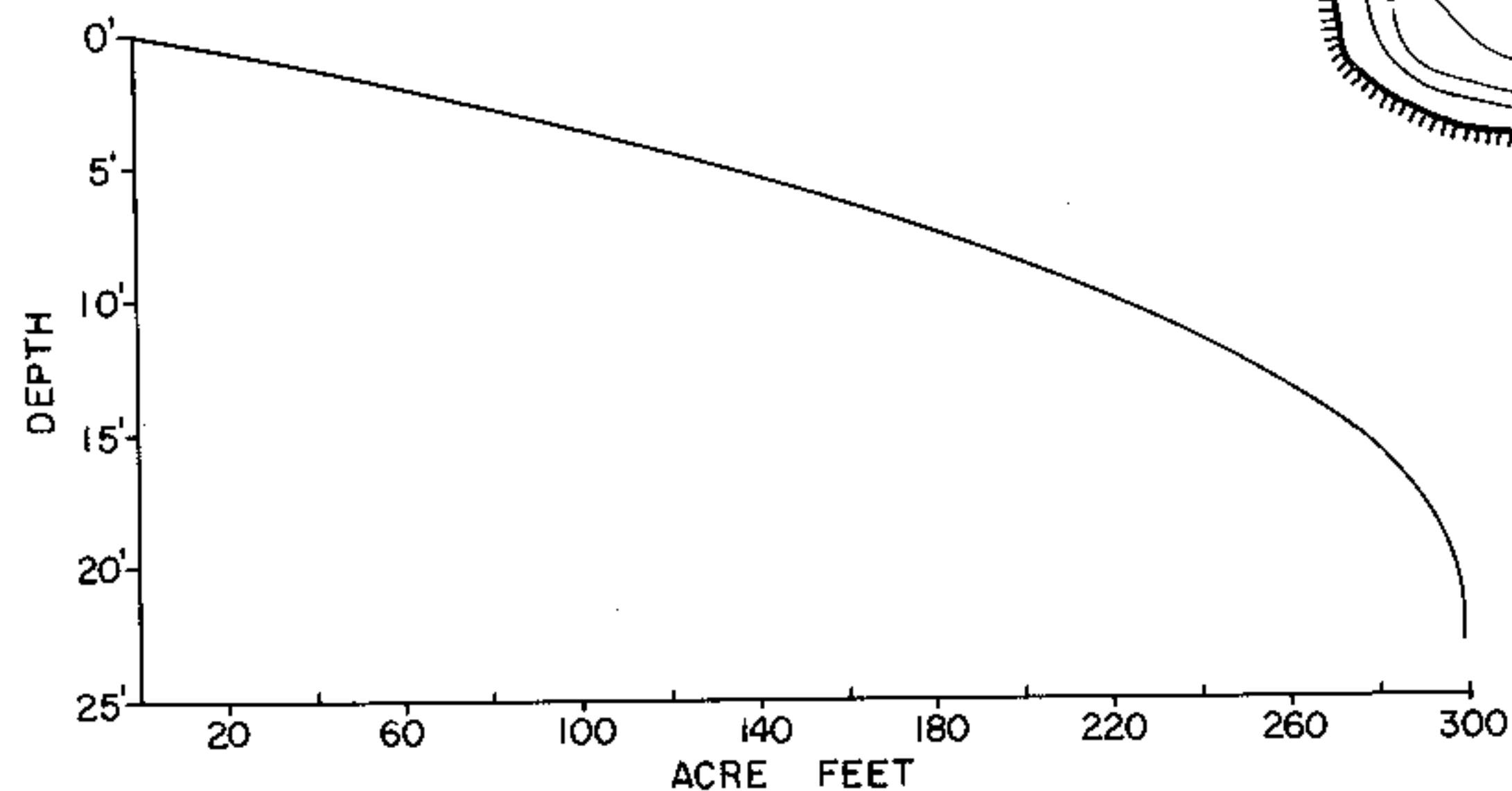
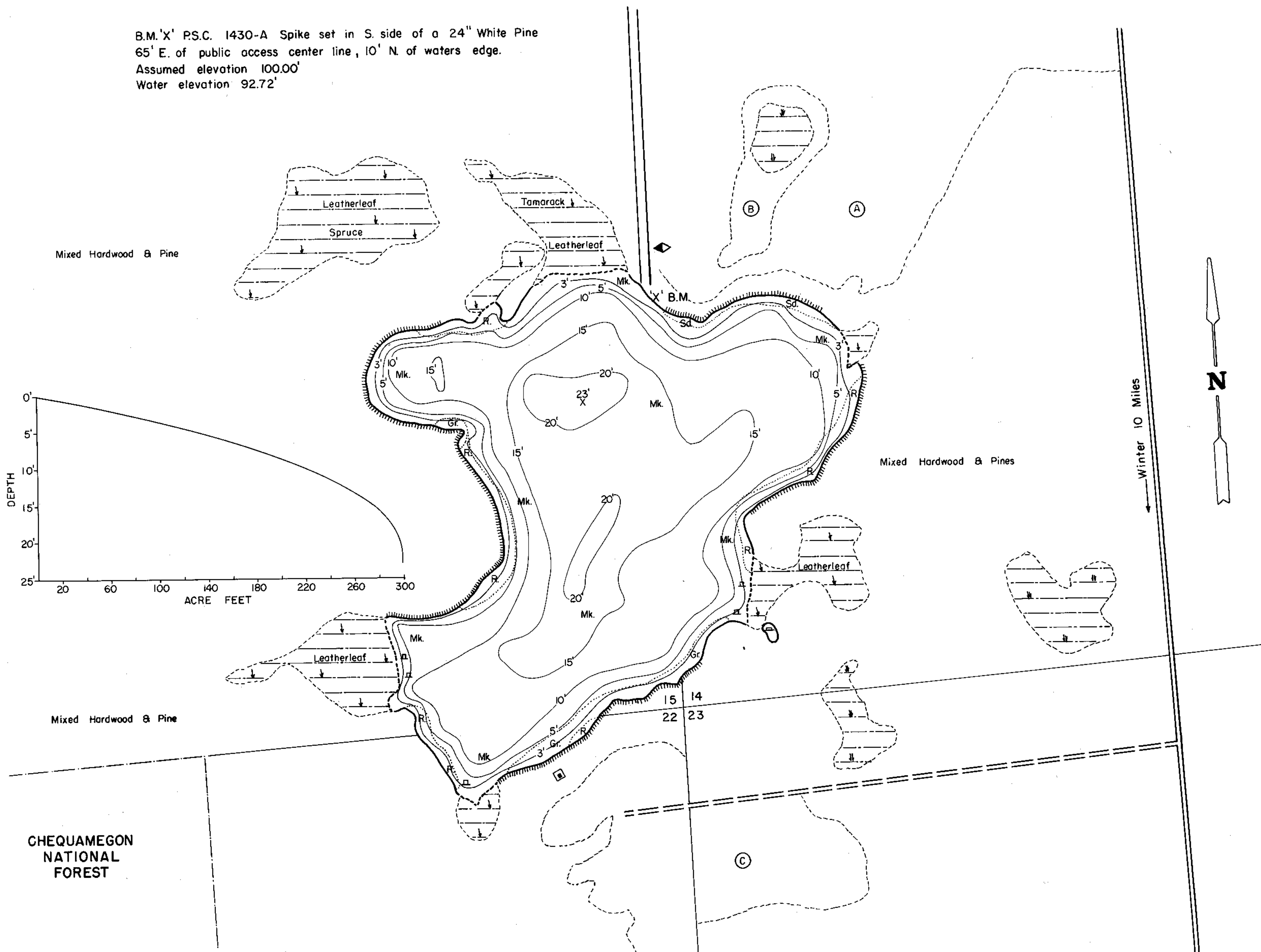


B.M. 'X' P.S.C. 1430-A Spike set in S. side of a 24" White Pine
