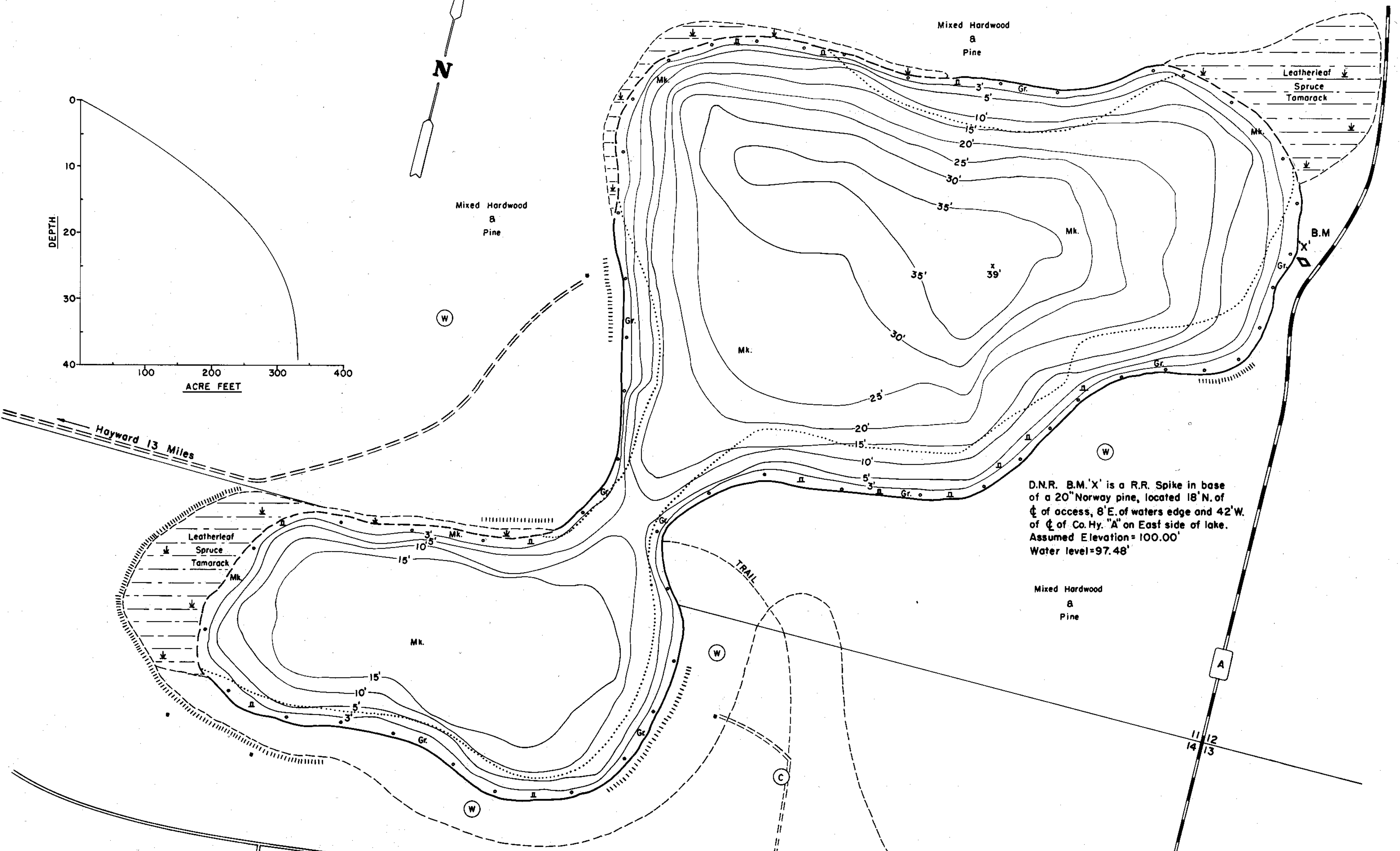


Hayward 13 Miles
