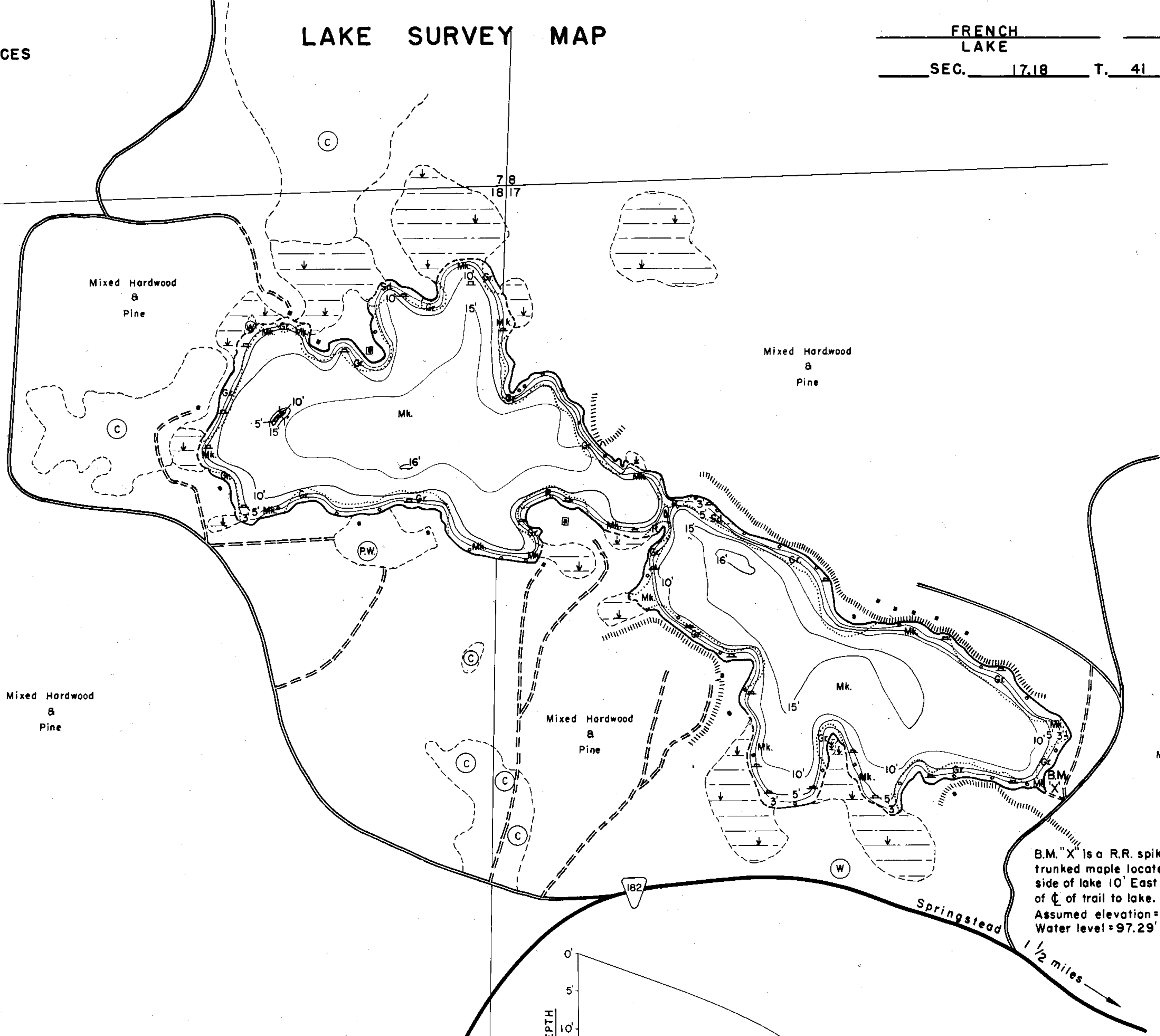
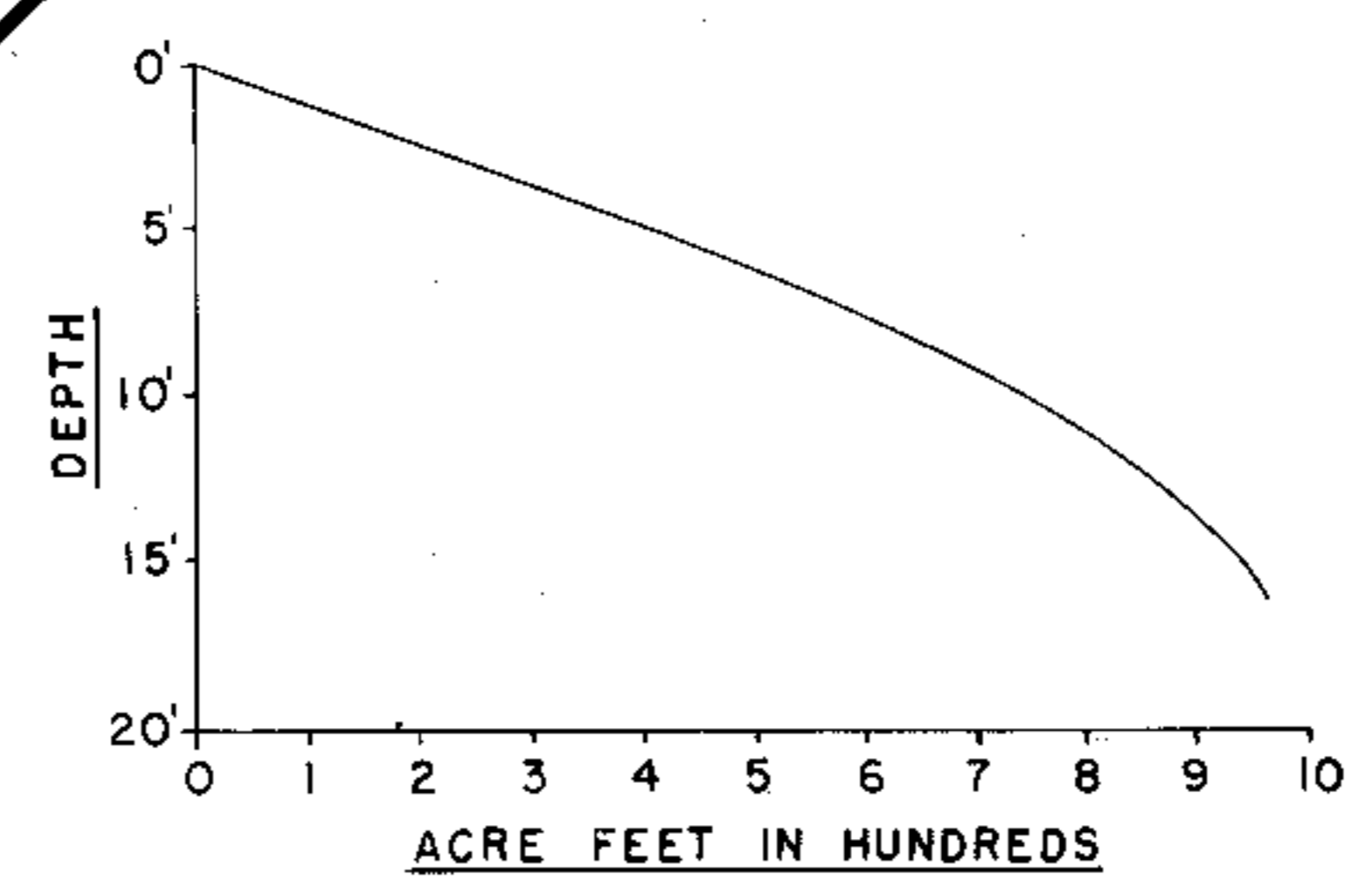




SCHOOL FOREST
