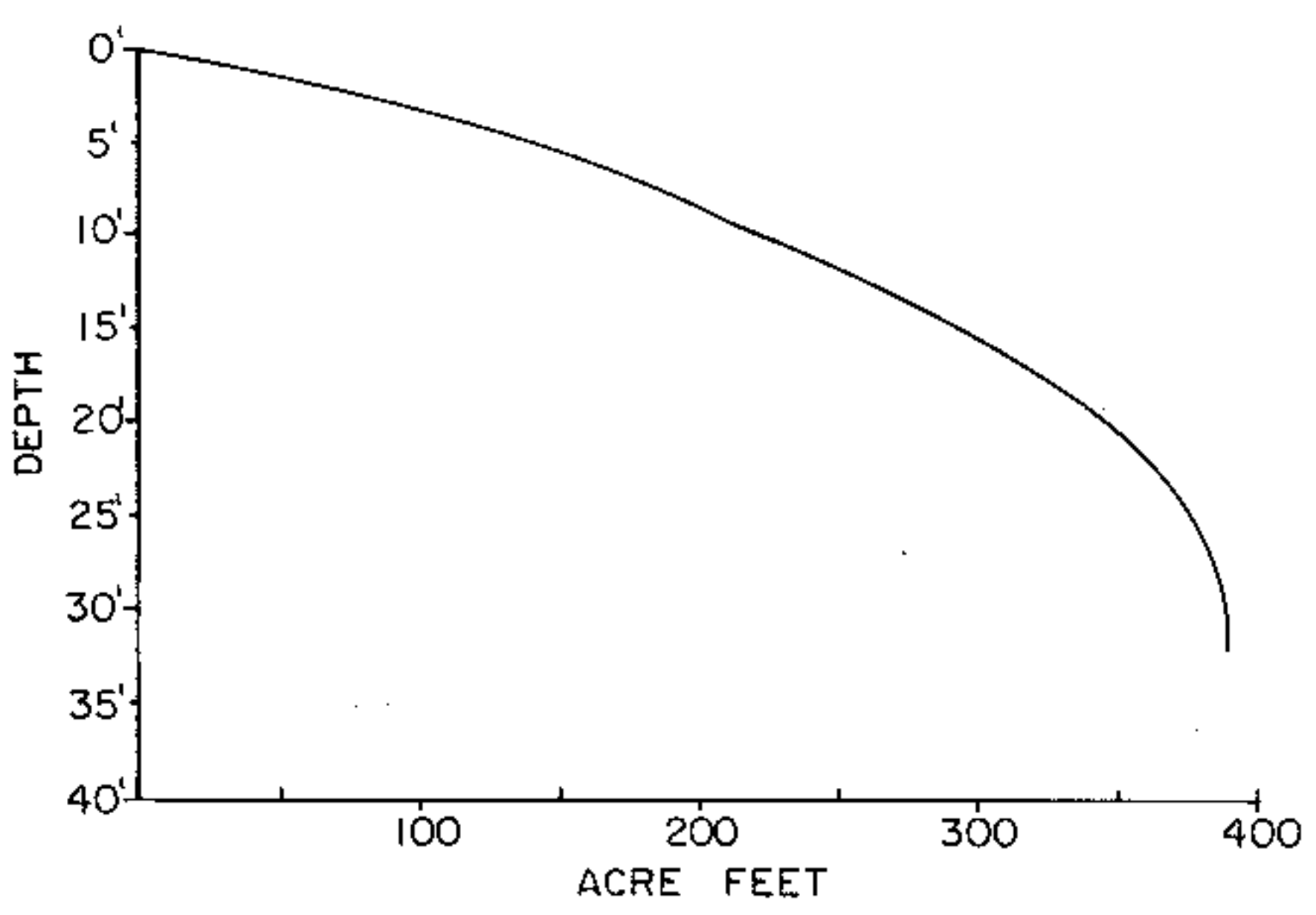


B.M. 'X' Large spike in oak tree 2.56' above its base. Oak on point of land on E. side of lake, 16' from waters edge
