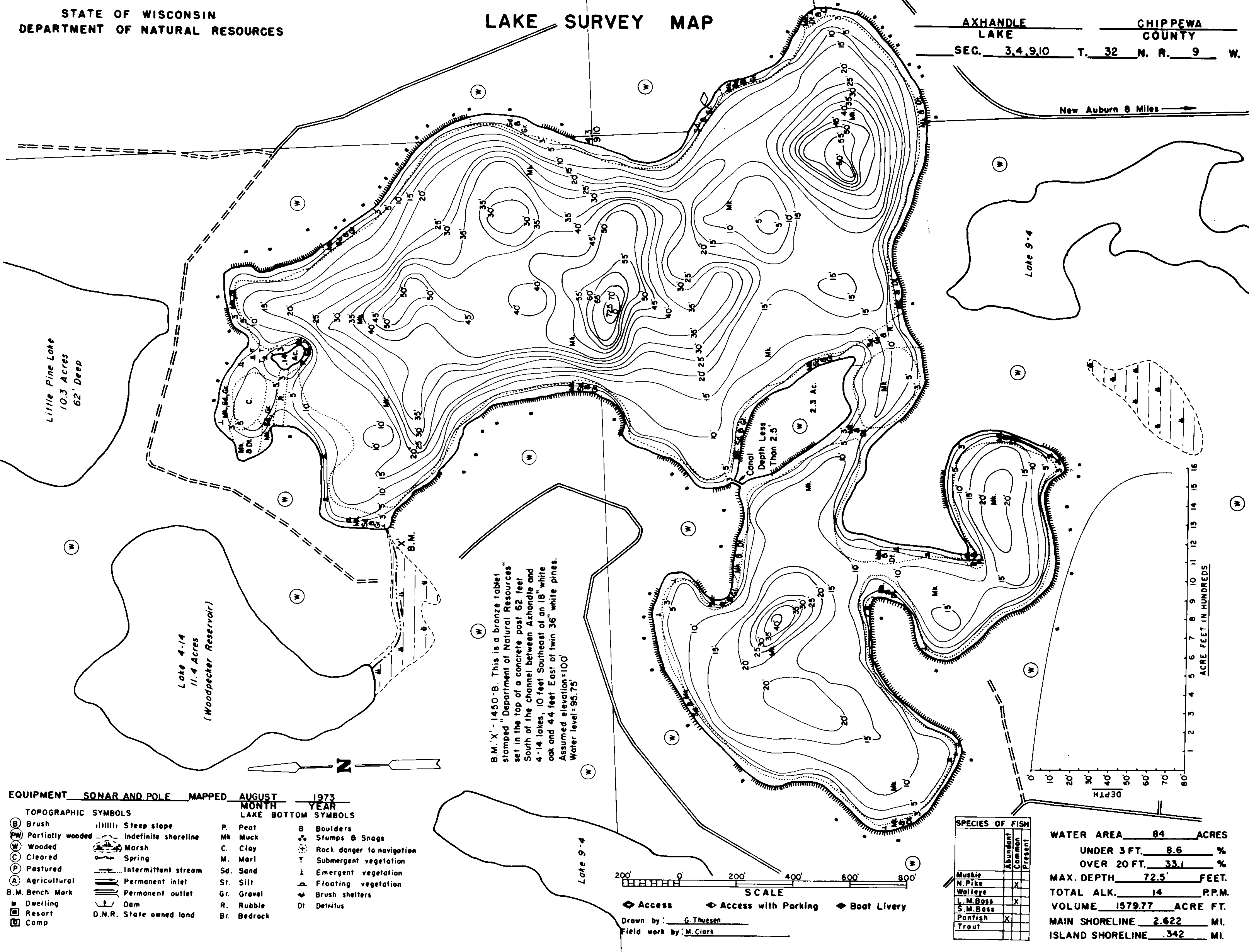

Assumed elevation=100' Water level=95.75'
