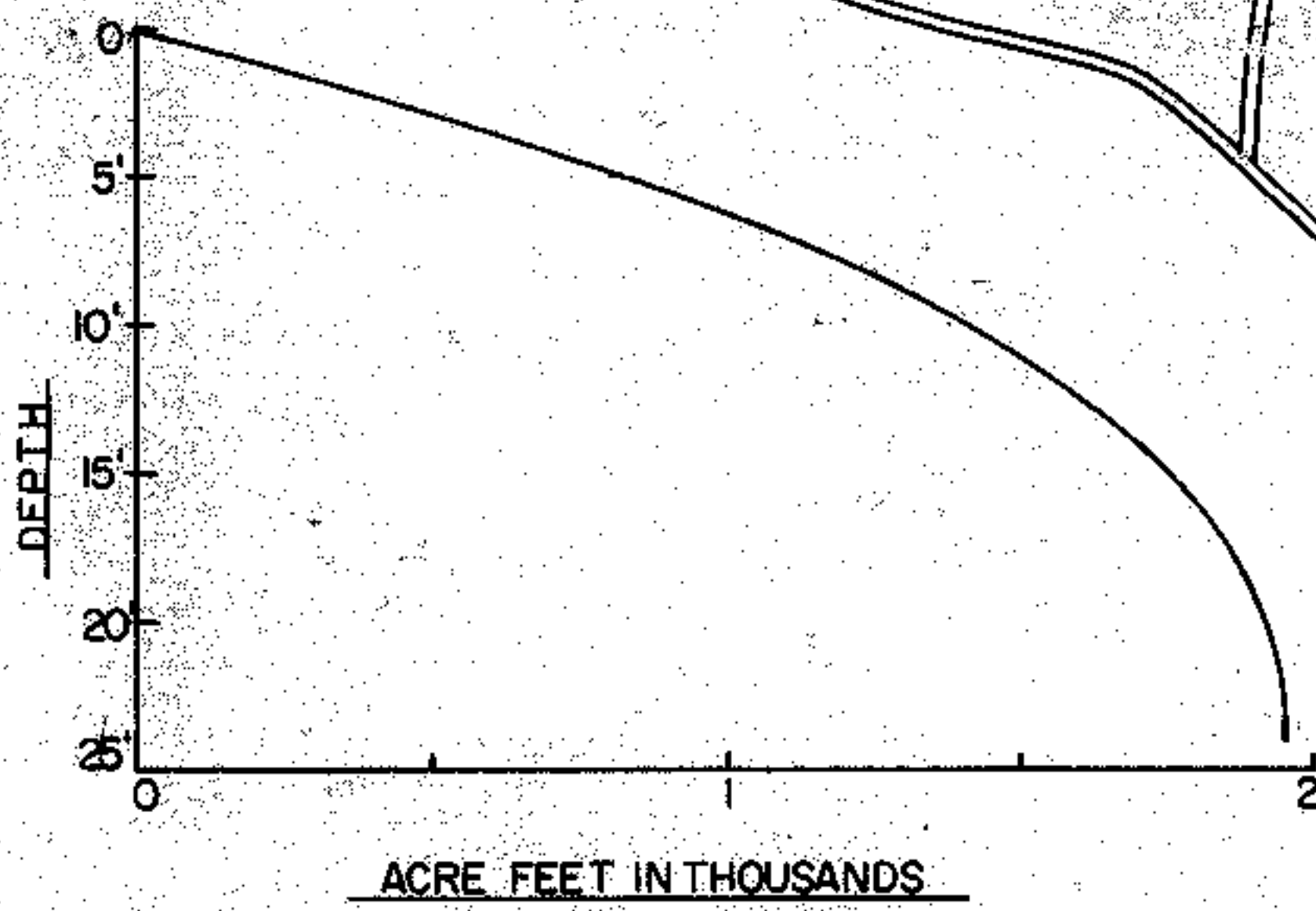
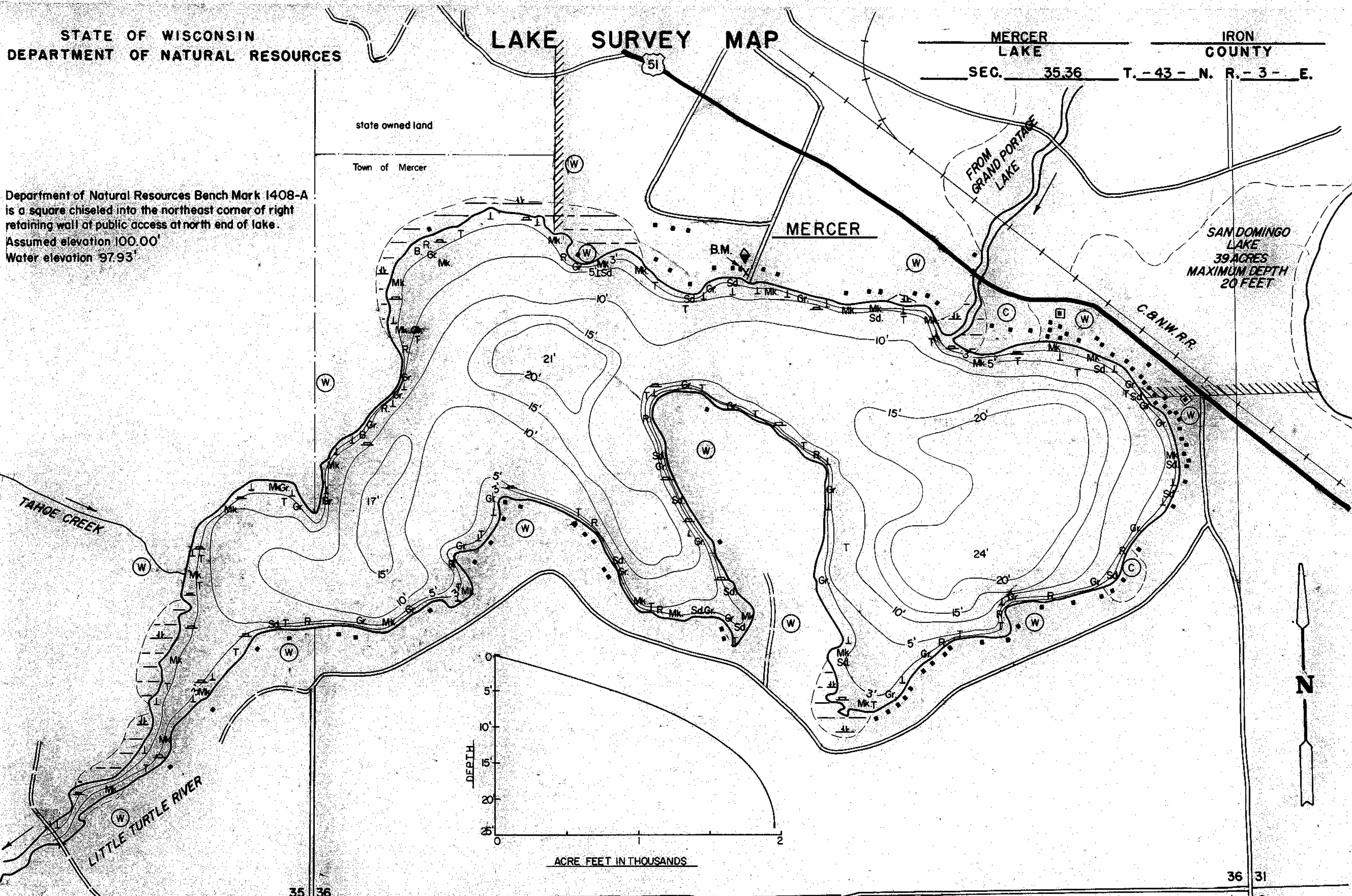


LAKE SURVEY MAP

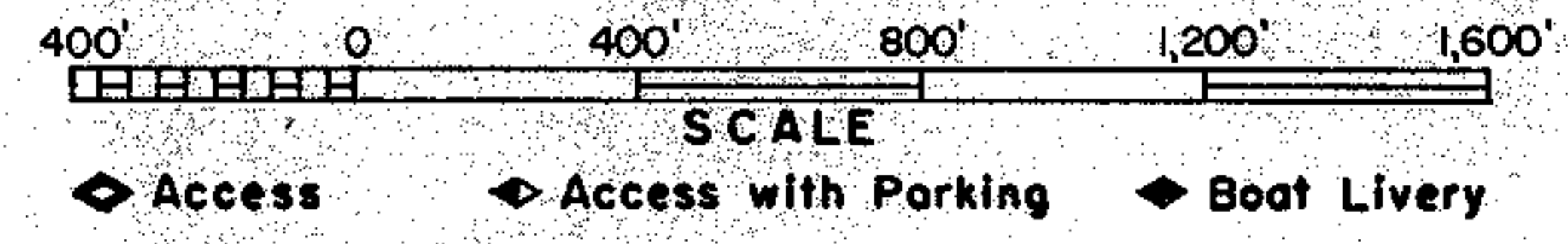
Department of Natural Resources Bench Mark 1408-A is a square chiseled into the northeast corner of right retaining wall at public access at north end of lake.
