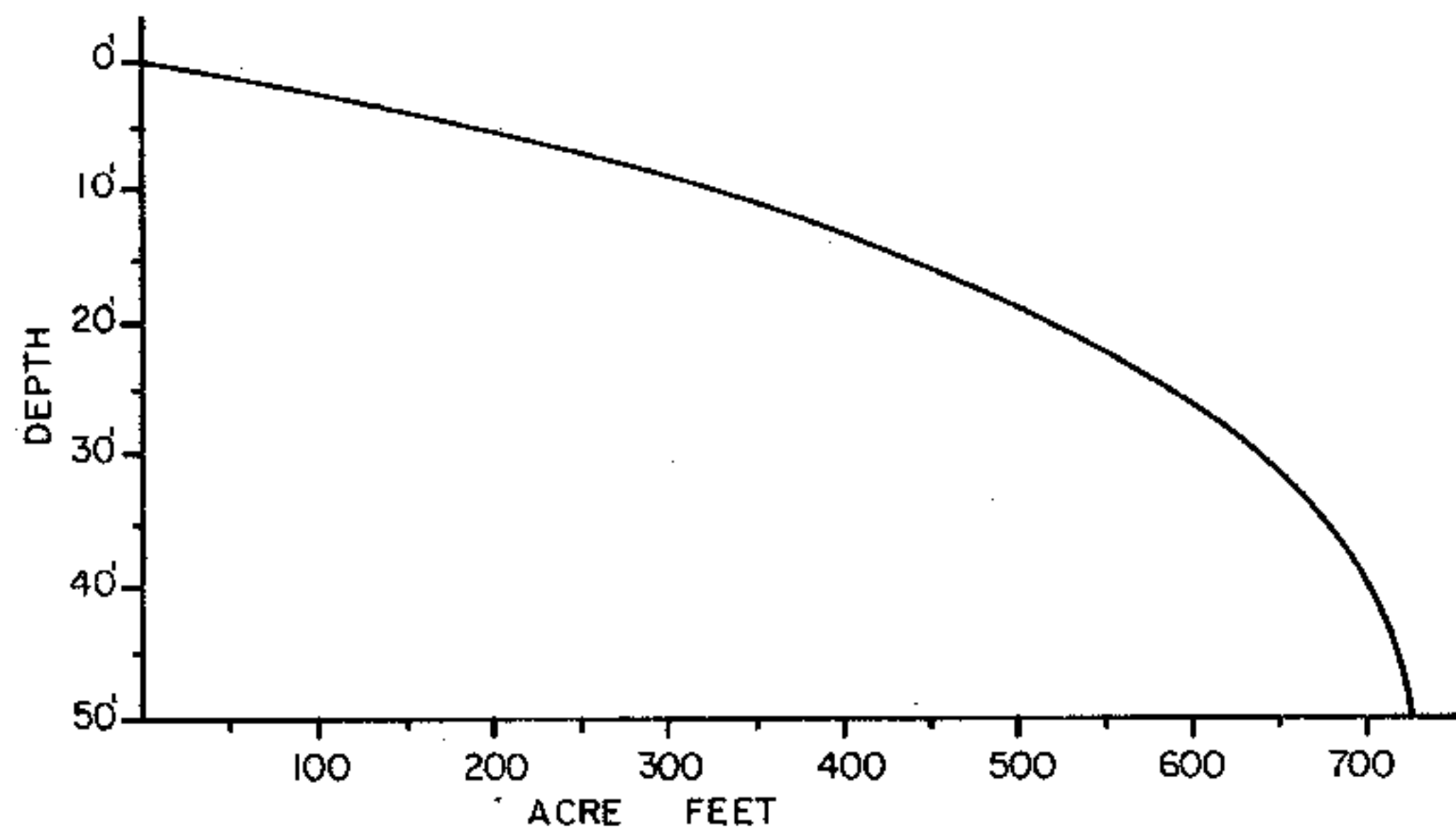
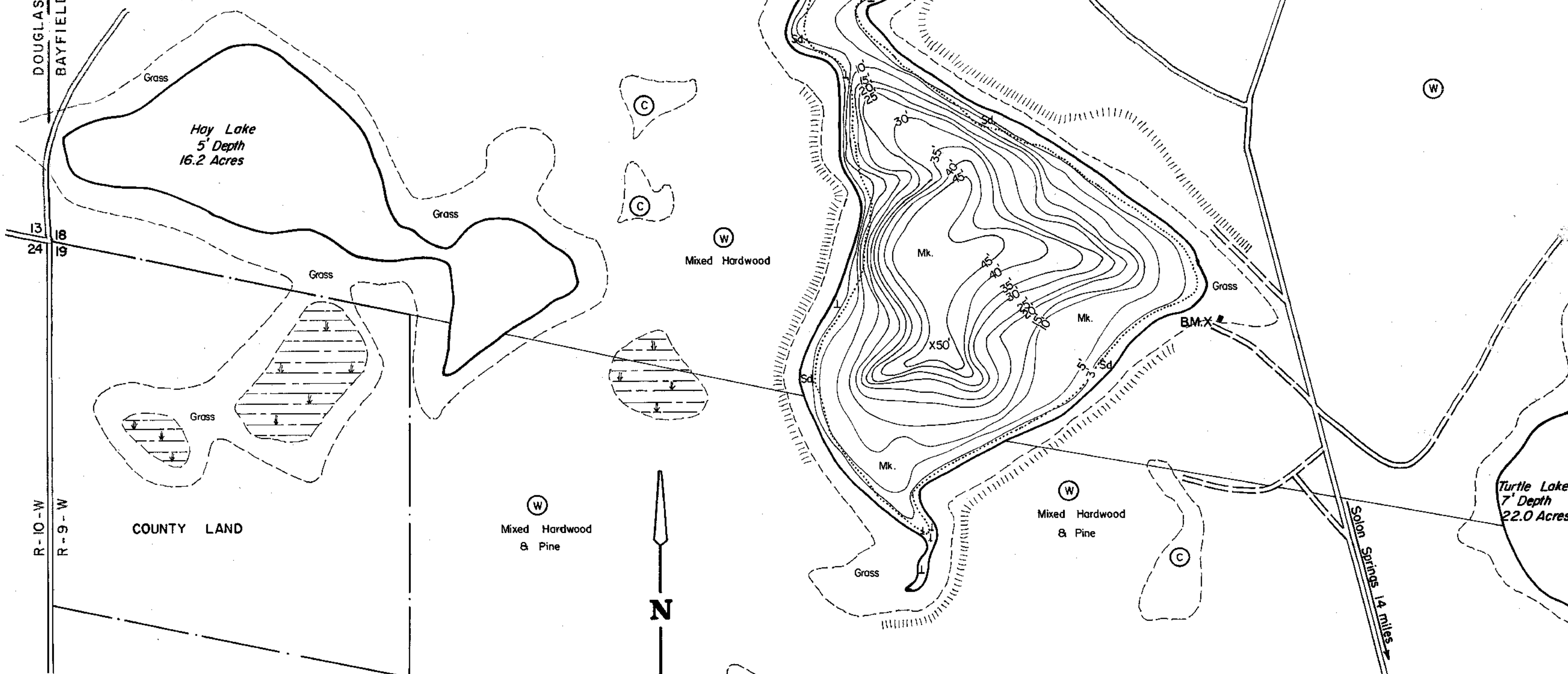


LAKE SURVEY MAP

SEC. 18, 19 T. 45 N. R. 9 W.



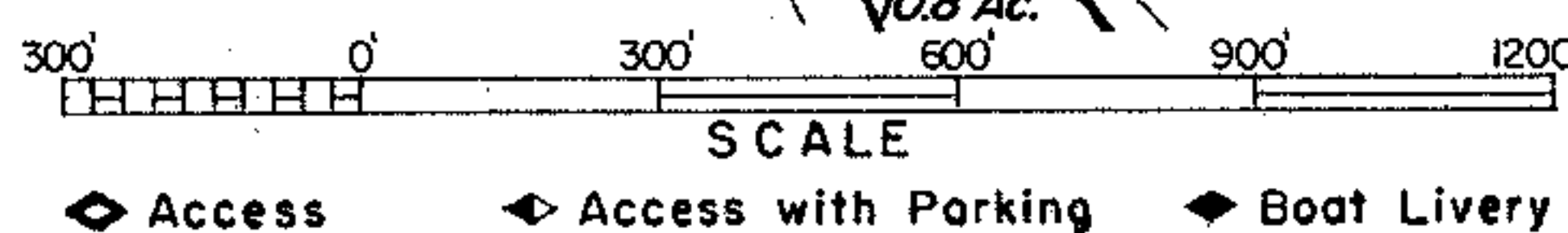
