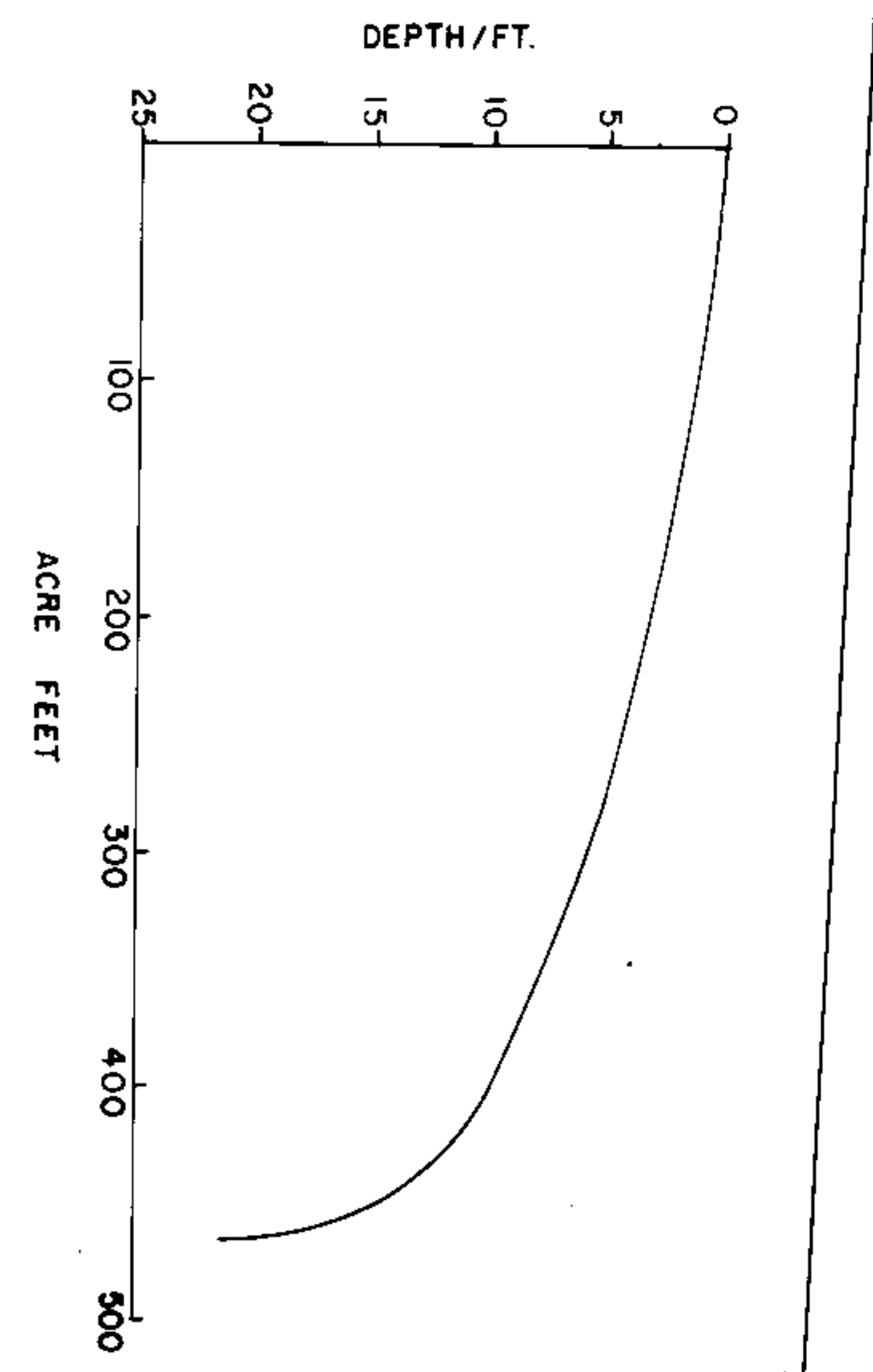


B.M. 1, Railroad Commission of Wis.
