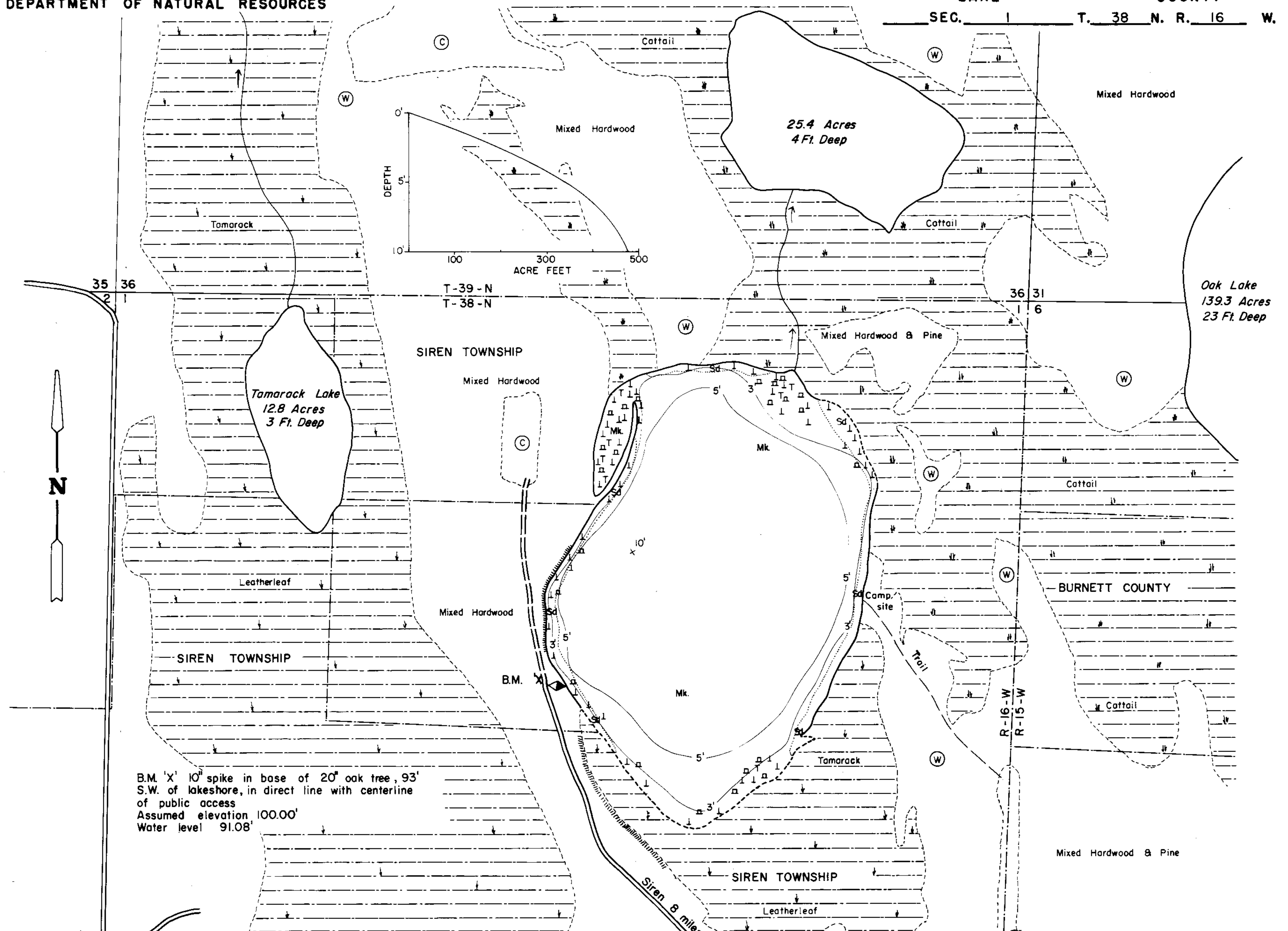


LAKE SURVEY MAP
