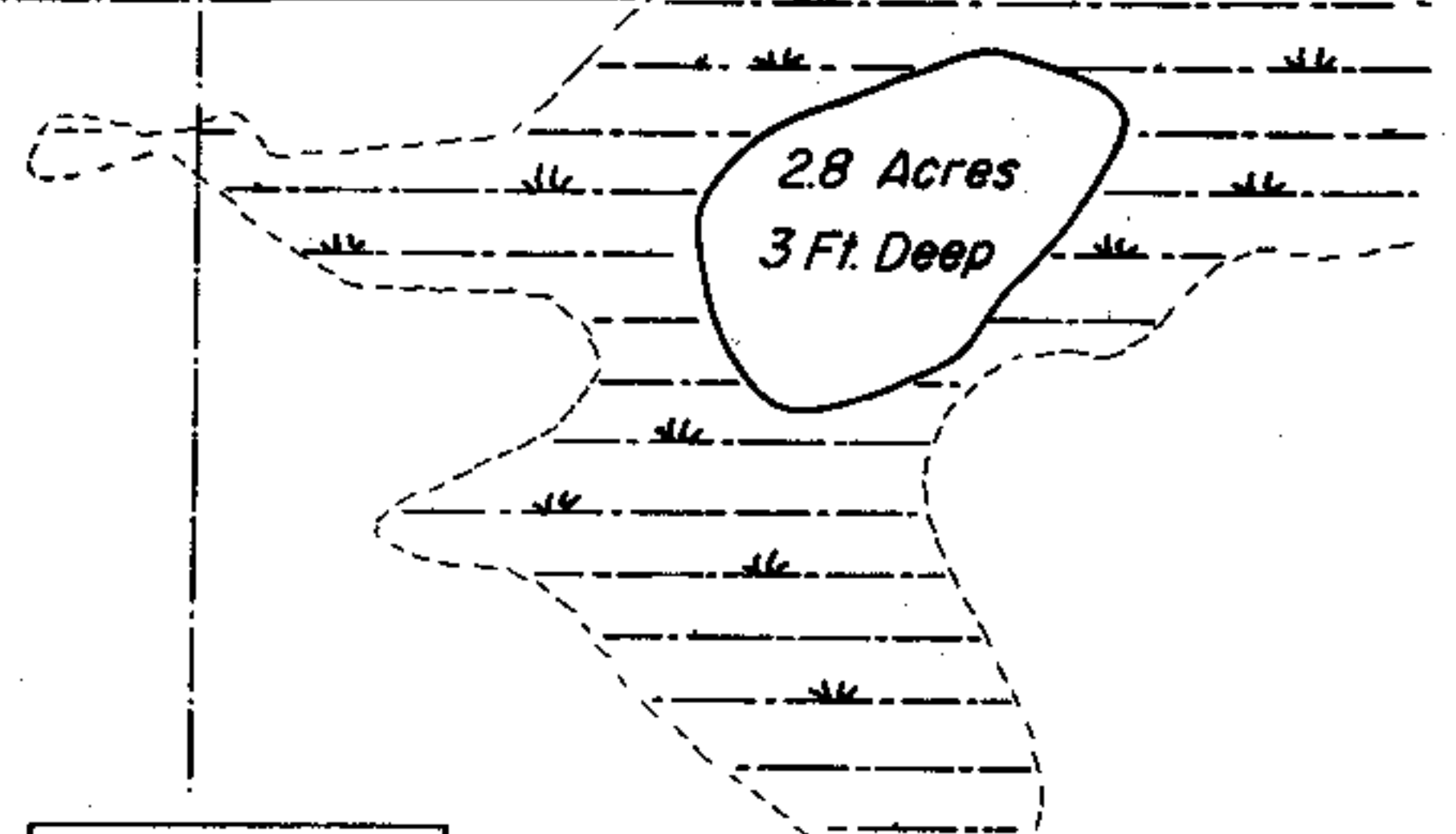


B.M. X' D.N.R. 1460-A Bronze tablet set in concrete post 50' W. of water, SW. side of lake
