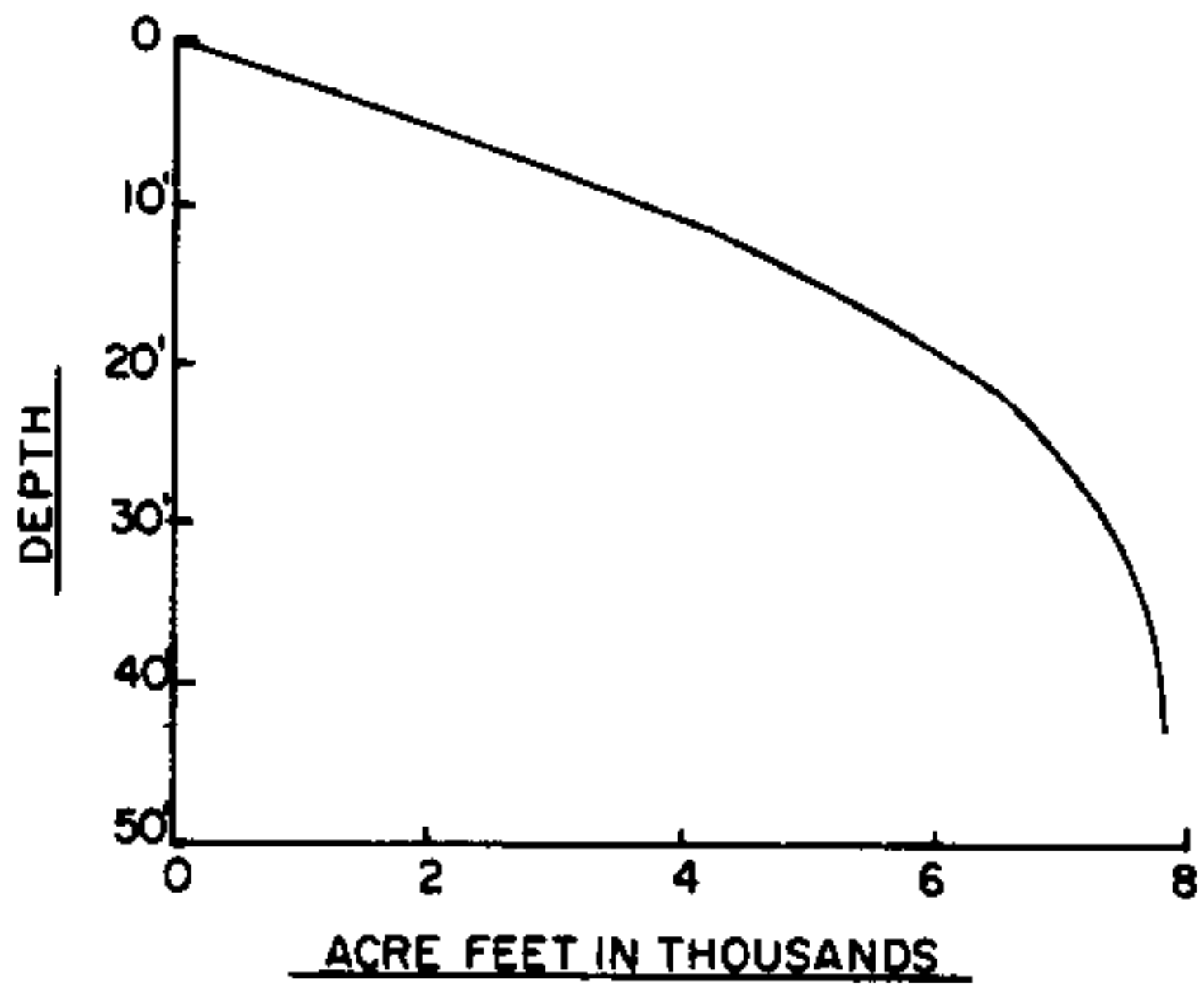


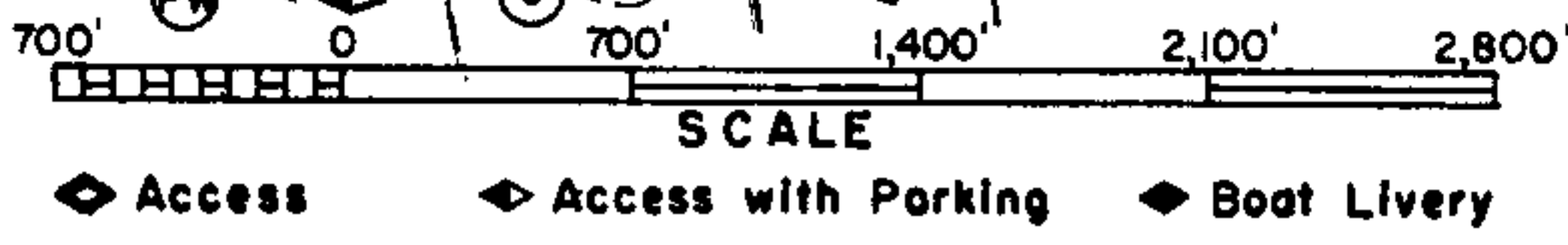
DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES BENCH MARK 1480-A.
