ORDINANCE NO: 2008-09-05 SLOW-NO-WAKE ZONE FOR ELK CREEK LAKE

A Sole Ordinance to Regulate Boating Upon the Waters of Elk Creek Lake and Prescribing Penalties for Violations Thereof.

The Town Board of the Town of Union, Eau Claire County do ordain as follows:

Section I. Applicability and Enforcement

- (a) The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the waters of Elk Creek Lake.
- (b) This chapter shall be enforced by the officers of the Town of Union, Eau Claire County and the officers of the Town of Spring Brook, Dunn County, working cooperatively with officers of the Eau Claire County, State of Wisconsin; Dunn County, State of Wisconsin; and the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources.
- (c) This ordinance shall not apply to official emergency personnel providing emergency services or to official emergency personnel engaged in training approved by the agency's chief of emergency services.

Section II. Intent

The intent of this Ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests, and the capability of the water resources.

Section III. State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted

State boating laws as found in SS. 30.50 to 30.71, Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

Section IV. <u>Definitions</u>

- (a) "Slow-no-wake" means that speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control.
- (b) "Elk Creek Lake" means all bays, lake area and back waters of the Elk Creek Lake area of Sect 18 Twp 27N, Range 10W and Sections 13 and 24, Twp 27N, Range 11W all in the Town of Spring Brook, Dunn Co., WI and the Town of Union, Eau Claire Co., WI.

Section V. Controlled Area

No person shall operate a boat or water craft faster than slow-no-wake in the waters of Elk Creek Lake at any time.

Section VI. Posting Requirements

The Towns of Union, Eau Claire Co., and Spring Brook, Dunn Co. shall place and maintain a synopsis of this ordinance at all public access points within their respective jurisdictions pursuant to the requirements of NR 5.15 Wis. Admin. Code.

Section VII. Penalties

Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in Wis. Stat. 30.80 and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, are hereby adopted by reference and all references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted.

Section VIII. Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town of Union Board would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the applications to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

Section IX. Effective Date

This section will become effective upon passage and the day after publication.
