TOWN OF HUNTER SLOW-NO-WAKE AREA ORDINANCE NO. 2011-01

A SOLE ORDINANCE TO REGULATE BOATING UPON THE WATER OF THE CHIPPEWA FLOWAGE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THERREOF.

The Town Board of the Town of Hunter do ordain as follows:

SECTION I- Applicability and Enforcement

- (a) The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the waters of the Chippewa Flowage at The Landing
- (b) This chapter shall be enforced by the officers of the Town of Hunter

SECTION II - Intent

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest, and the capability of the water resources.

SECTION III - State Boating & Safety Laws Adopted

State boating laws as found in 30.50 to 30.71 of the Wisconsin Statutes, are adopted by reference.

SECTION IV – Definitions

- (a) "Slow-no-wake" means that speed at which a boat moves as slow as possible while still maintaining steerage control.
- (b) No person shall operate a boat faster than slow-no-wake any time in the waters of the Chippewa Flowage at The Landing Resort starting at cabin #7 to the gas pumps.

SECTION V – Hours of Operation

No person shall operate a boat faster than slow-no-wake during the hours of 6 a.m. to 9 p.m. local time on the Chippewa Flowage at The Landiing.

SECTION VI – Posting Requirements

DNR ID#0947

The Town of Hunter shall place and maintain a synopsis of this ordinance at all public access points within the jurisdiction of the Town of Hunter pursuant to the requirements of NR 5.15 Wis. Admin Code.

SECTION VII – Penalties

Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in Wis. Statutes 30.80, and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, are hereby adopted by reference and all references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted.

SECTION VIII - Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town Board would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

SECTION IX - Effective Date

This section will become effective upon passage and the day after publication.
