## AN ORDINANCE BY THE ANSON TOWN BOARD ORDINANCE NUMBER 030182

The purpose of this ordinance is to regulate water traffic, boating and water sports upon the waters of Pheffercorn lake and prescribing penalties thereof.

The Town board of the township of Anson, Chippewa County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Section 1: Intent-

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistant with public rights and interest and the capability of water resources.

Section 2: Applicability and Enforcement—
The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of lake Pheffercorn within the jurisdiction of the town of Anson. The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by the town constable of the Town of Anson.

Section 3: State water and Boating Safety Laws Adopted—
The statuatory provisions describing and defining regulations with respect to water traffic, boats, boating and water related activities and safety in the following enumerated sections of the Wisc. Statutes, exclusive of and provisions therein related to the penalties to be imposed or the punishment for violation of said statutes, are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this ordinance.

Section 4: Adopt to Pheffercorn LakeDo hereby place a slow no wake speed limit on Pheffercorn lake.
We do this with the public safety in mind, we are also concerned with and for the aquatic life inhabiting Pheffercorn lake which is 16 acres.

Section 5: Penalties—
Penalties shall be in accordance with Chapter 30.80 Wisconsin Statutes, hereby included by reference. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall forfeit not more than \$50. for the first offense and shall forfeit not more than \$100. upon conviction of the same offense a second or subsequent time within one year.

Section 6: <u>Wisconsin Statutes Defined</u>—
Wherever used in this ordinance the term "Wisconsin Statutes" shall mean the Wisconsin Statuted of 1959 and subsequent ammendments.

Section 4: Adopt To Pheffercorn Lake:

We the members of the Anson town board do hereby place a slow to no wake speed limit on Pheffercorn lake which is in the jurisdiction of the Town of Anson.

Being that the lake is under 50 acres and to narrow and to shallow for safe excessive speed travel. We do this with the public safety in mind, we are also concerned with and for the aquatic life inhabiting Pheffercorn lake.

By adopting this ordinance we shall bring the rules governing Pheffercorn lake up to standard with all the other 50 acre or less lakes in the state of Wisconsin, which are governed by Wisconsin Statutes 30.635 and 30.66.
