AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO PARK LAKE.

888

THE VILLAGE BOARD, of the Village of Pardeeville, Columbia County, Wisconsin does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Intent. The intent of this Ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of the aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest and the capability of the water resources of Park Lake located and adjoining the Village of Pardeeville, Columbia County, Wisconsin.

Section 2. Applicability and Enforcement. The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the waters of Park Lake within the jurisdiction of the Village of Pardeeville, Columbia County, Wisconsin. The Provisions of this Ordinance shall be enforced by the Village Police Department, but such enforcement shall not be limited to them specifically.

Section 3. State Boating and Water Laws Adopted. The statutory provisions describing and defining regulations with respect to Water traffic, boats, boating and related water activities and safety in the following enumerated sections of the Wisconsin Statutes, exclusive of any provisions therein relating to the penalties to be imposed or the punishment for violation of said statutes, are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this Ordinance.

Section 6. Penalties. Any person who shall violate any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit not less than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00), and the costs of prosecution.

Section 7. Severability. The several provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Village Board would have passed the other provisions of this Ordinance, irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid and if any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be effected thereby.

THIS ORDINANCE shall take effect and be enforced after passage and publication as provided for by law, and after approval by the Department of Natural Resources, State of Wisconsin.

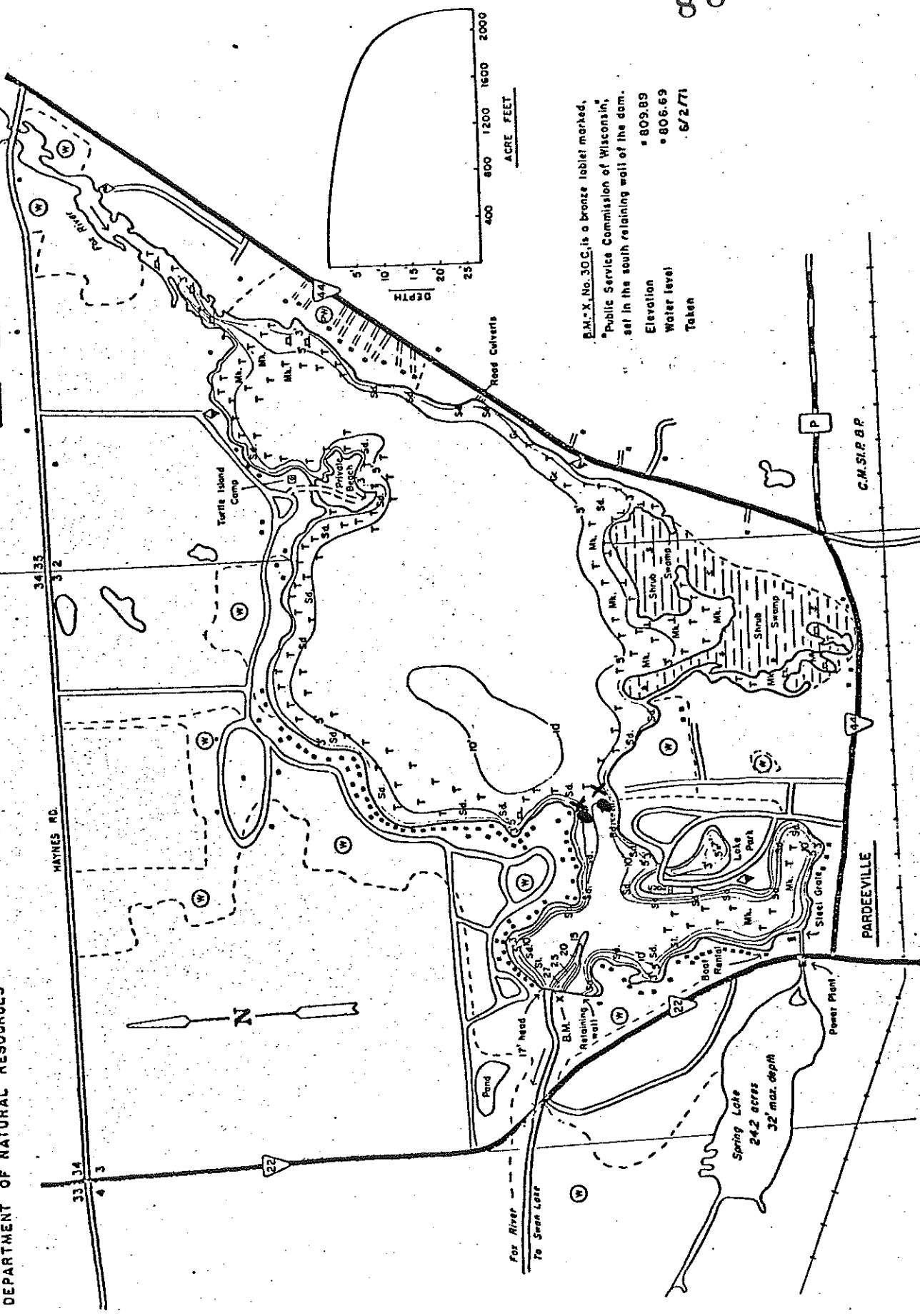

LAKE SURVEY MAP

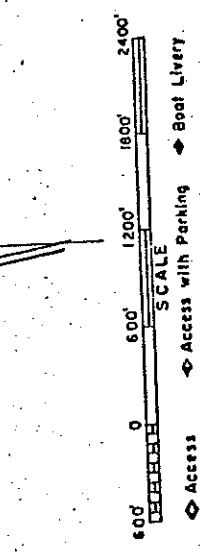
