

ORDINANCE 2003-02

A SOLE ORDINANCE TO REGULATE BOATING UPON THE WATERS OF
CURRIER LAKE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

The Town of Round Lake Board of the County of Sawyer do ordain as follows:

Section I. Applicability and Enforcement

- a.) The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the waters of Currier Lake.
- b.) This chapter shall be enforced by Sawyer County or any officer of the Town of Round Lake appointed by the Board of Supervisors of the Town of Round Lake.

Section II. Intent:

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest, and the capability of the water resources.

Section III. State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted

State boating laws as found in ss. 30.50 to 30.71, Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

Section IV. Definitions

Section V. Gas Powered Motor Boat Prohibited

No person shall operate a motorboat, as defined in 30.50(6), Wisconsin Statutes, that is propelled by an internal combustion engine or engines on the waters of Currier Lake. Electric motors only are permitted on said waters.

Section VI. Posting Requirements

The Town of Round Lake shall place and maintain a copy of this Ordinance at all public access points within the jurisdiction of the Town of Round Lake pursuant to the requirements of NR 5.15 Wis. Admin. Code.

Section VII. Penalties

Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in Wis. Stat. 30.80, and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, are hereby adopted by reference and all references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted.


Section VIII. Severability

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town of Round Lake Board would have passed the other provisions of this ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.


Section IX Effective Date

This section will become effective upon passage and the day after publication.


