Ordinance No. 12-2012

WHEREAS, the Forest County Board of Supervisors approved and adopted Ordinance #04-2012 on April 17, 2012 pertaining to the seizure and surrender of animals; and WHEREAS, the Ordinance allowed for, among other things, the impounding of dogs and the requirement that municipalities of Forest County would be responsible for the costs associated with impoundment if the owner did not pay; and WHEREAS, various municipalities throughout Forest County objected to the imposition of the costs associated with dogs being impounded; and

WHEREAS, Forest County does not have the resources available to impound dogs running at large without incurring additional costs to the Sheriff's Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE FOREST COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS as follows:

SECTION I. That the portion of Ordinance #04-2012 pertaining to the "Impounding of Dogs" shall be removed in its entirety.

SECTION II. That all other provisions of the Forest County Ordinance adopted by the Forest County Board of Supervisors on April 17, 2012, as may have been amended from time to time, shall continue to remain in full force and effect, except as specifically modified herein.

That the provisions of the current Forest SECTION III. County Ordinance, as amended from time to time, are hereby repealed insofar as any term, provision, or condition conflicts with

the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its adoption and publication pursuant to law.

A joint ordinance to regulate boating upon the waters of Crys-

A joint ordinance to regulate boating upon the Waters of Crystal Lake and prescibing; penalties for violations thereof.

The Townships of Langlade, Ainsworth (Langlade County) and Nashville (Forest County) do jointly ordain as follows:

Section I: Applicability and Enforcement

(a) The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of Crystal Lake located in The Townships of Langlade Indianactic County and the Townships of Langlade In Ainsworth in Langlade County and the Township of Nashville in

Forest County.

(b) This chapter shall be enforced by the officers of Langlade and Forest County Sheriff's Departments; and any other

officer having jurisdiction.

Section II: Intent
The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and

healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests, and the capability of the water resources

Section III: State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted
State boating laws as found in ss.30.50 to 30.71, Wis.
Stats, are adopted by reference.
Section IV: Definitions

(a) "Slow No Wake" means that speed of which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage con-

trol.

Section V: Hours of Operation

No person shall operate a motor boat or personal water craft faster than "Slow No Wake" during the hours of 6 p.m. to 10

craft faster than "Slow No Wake" during the hours of 6 p.m. to 10 a.m. local time on Crystal Lake.

Section VI: Posting Requirements

The Crystal Lake Association shall place and maintain a synopsis of this ordinance at all public access points within the jurisdiction of the respective Townships pursuant to the requirements of NR 5.15 Wis. Admin. code.

Section VIII: Possibles

Section VII: Penalties
Wisconsin State boating penalties as found in Wis. Stat.
30.80, and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, are hereby adopted by reference and all references to imprisonment

Section VIII: Effective Date
This section will become effective upon passage by all

Townships and the day after publication.
