TOWN OF DOTY - ORDINANCE NO. 19 - 7/5/95

RE: "SLOW-NO-WAKE" BUOY PLACEMENT ALONG WEST BAYS ON BOULDER LAKE, TOWN OF DOTY, OCONTO COUNTY

The Town Board of Supervisors, Town of Doty, Oconto County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Intent

The intent of this buoy placement is to protect the aquatic vegetation development that is important as a nursery for small fish resources and also the safety of boaters.

Section 2. Applicability and Enforcement

The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of Boulder Lake. Provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by the officers of the Town of Doty, together with any and all State and County officers authorized by law to enforce the same.

Section 3. Definitions

"Slow-no-wake" means the slowest possible speed so as to still maintain steerage.

(a) All "slow-no-wake" areas shall be designated by buoys which meet the standards set forth in Section N.R.S. 09, Wisconsin Administrative Code.

Section 4. Description

The placement of (7) buoys (slow-no-wake waterway markers) along the west bays of Boulder Lake. Buoys start forming a line 100' N.E. of the north lot line of #N3371, continuing N.E. to Traxel Point. The buoys then continue N.E. from Traxel Point to a land marked cluster of boulders on the waters edge, approximately 600' east of the east lot line of Government Lot #5.

Section 5. Adopting State Statutes

The Town of Doty hereby adopts, along with this ordinance and incorporates the same herein by reference, all the provisions of Section 30.50 through 30.81 of the revised statutes of the State of Wisconsin, being Regulations for Boating.

Section 6. Penalties

Any person who violates the provisions adopted by this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit such amounts as set forth in Sections 30.50 through 30.81, inclusive, of the revised statutes of the State of Wisconsin, for each violation.

TOWN OF DOTY - ORDINANCE NO. 20 - 7/5/95

RE: BOATING AND WATER SAFETY ORDINANCE FOR BOULDER LAKE,
TOWN OF DOTY, OCONTO COUNTY.

The Town Board of Supervisors of the Town of Doty, Oconto County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows....

Section 1. Intent

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest and the capability of the water resource.

Section 2. Applicability and Enforcement

The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of Boulder Lake. Provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by the officers of the Town of Doty, together with any and all State and County officers authorized by law to enforce the same.

Section 3. Water Ski Hours

Prohibiting certain times and exceptions, (see section 4) no person shall operate a motor boat towing a person on water skis, aquaplane or similar device, except between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

Section 4. Speed Limit

Between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m., a 10 mph speed limit will be enforced. This speed limit is set as a guide for motorboats to operate in a reasonable and prudent manner for the safety and welfare of all other boaters on the lake.

(a) The above does not apply to duly authorized water ski tournaments, competitions, exhibitions or trials therefore where adequate lighting is provided and where written permission to stage such tournaments, competitions or exhibitions has been received from the Town Board of the Town of Doty, Oconto County, Wisconsin.

Section 5. Adopting State Statutes

Except as hereinabove specifically provides, the Town of Doty hereby adopts, along with this ordinance and incorporates the same herein by reference, all the provisions of Section 30.50 through 30.81 of the revised statutes of the State of Wisconsin, being Regulations for Boating.

Section 6. Penalties and Deposits

Any person who violates the provisions adopted by this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit such amounts as set forth in Sections 30.50 through 30.81, inclusive, of the revised statutes of the State of Wisconsin, for each violation.

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Section 7. Posting and Filing of Ordinance

Upon final adoption of this ordinance, the Town Clerk shall post a copy of said ordinance at all public and private accesses on Boulder Lake affected and shall file a copy of said ordinance with the office of the Department of Natural Resources.

This ordinance shall become effective upon publication as provided by law.
