AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCES ADOPTED BY THE CITY OF OCONOMOWOC, VILLAGE OF LAC LABELLE AND TOWN OF OCONOMOWOC REGULATING WATER TRAFFIC, BOATING AND WATER SPORTS UPON THE WATERS OF LAC LABELLE

The Common Council of the City of Oconomowoc, the Village Board of the Village of Lac LaBelle and the Town Board of the Town of Oconomowoc, each being a municipality as defined in Chapter 30 of the Wisconsin Statutes, and each having jurisdiction of a portion of Lac LaBelle, an Inland Lake located in Waukesha County, do jointly and identically in conformity with Sections 30.77 and 30.81 of the Wisconsin Statutes, ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 21.14(3) of the Municipal Code of the City of Oconomowoc is renumbered 21.14(4) and a new section 21.14(3) is created to read as follows:

SECTION 21.14 (3) SPECIAL SPEED LIMIT.

No person shall, at any time operate a boat in excess of slow-no-wake in an area from a shore to shore line in Lac LaBelle, said line to be parallel to and approximately 1,100 feet north of the city beach, extending east and west from a point on the shore of property located at 326 N. Lake Road to a point on the shore of property located at 259 Woodland Lane. The area in which this special speed limit shall apply lies between the aforementioned line and the south shore of Lac LaBelle; and shall include the entire width of the bay as well as the channel circling the island located at the southwest corner of said bay.

SECTION 2. Section 20.02(3) of the Municipal Code of the Town of Oconomowoc is hereby created to read as follows:

SECTION 20.02 (3) SPECIAL SPEED LIMIT.

No person shall, at any time operate a boat in excess of slow-no-wake in an area from a shore to shore line in Lac LaBelle, said line to be parallel to and approximately 1,100 feet north of the city beach, extending east and west from a point on the shore of property located at 326 N. Lake Road to a point on the shore of property located at 259 Woodland Lane. The area in which this special speed limit shall apply lies between the aforementioned

line and the south shore of Lac LaBelle; and shall include the entire width of the bay as well as the channel circling the island located at the southwest corner of said bay.

SECTION 3. The Village of Lac LaBelle ordinance regulating water traffic, boats, boating and related water activities on Lac LaBelle is hereby amended to provide for a special speed limit on Lac LaBelle, said ordinance to read as follows:

SPECIAL SPEED LIMIT.

No person shall, at any time operate a boat in excess of slow-no-wake in an area from a shore to shore line in Lac LaBelle, said line to be parallel to and approximately 1,100 feet north of the city beach, extending east and west from a point on the shore of property located at 326 N. Lake Road to a point on the shore of property located at 259 Woodland Lane. The area in which this special speed limit shall apply lies between the aforementioned line and the south shore of Lac LaBelle; and shall include the entire width of the bay as well as the channel circling the island located at the southwest corner of said bay.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage by the City of Oconomowoc City Council, Village of Lac LaBelle Board of Trustees and Town of Oconomowoc Town Board and publication as provided by law.
