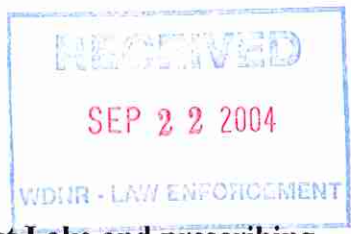

Ordinance #9

A sole ordinance to regulate boating upon the waters of Forest Lake and prescribing penalties for violations thereof:

The town board of Armstrong Creek, Forest County, does ordain as follows:

Section I – Applicability and Enforcement:

- (A) The provisions of the Ordinance shall apply to the waters of Forest Lake, located in section 1, T37N, R16E, fully in the town of Armstrong Creek, Forest County.
- (B) This chapter shall be enforced by the officers of the Town of Armstrong Creek.

Section II – Intent:

The intent of this Ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests and the capability of the water resources.

Section III – State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted:

State boating laws as found in ss.30.50 to 30.71 Wis. Stats. are adopted by reference.

Section IV – Definitions:

- (A) “Slow – No Wake” means that speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control.

Section V – Controlled Area:

No person shall operate a boat faster than slow – no wake in the waters of Forest Lake between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 11:00 a.m..

Section VI – Posting Requirements:

Due to the lack of public access to the lake, the Town of Armstrong Creek shall place a synopsis of this ordinance on all roads surrounding or leading to Forest Lake within the town of Armstrong Creek, pursuant to the requirements of NR5.15 WI. Administrative Code.

Section VII – Penalties:

Wisconsin state boating penalties as found in Wis. Stats. 30.80 and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference are hereby adopted by reference and all references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted.

Section VIII – Severability:

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town Board would have passed the other provisions of this Ordinance, irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

Section IX – Effective Date:

This section shall become effective upon passage and the day after publication.
