Ordinance For "Slow-No-Wake" Area

A SOLE ORDINANCE TO REGULATE BOATING UPON THE WATERS OF JACKSON LAKE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Township of Grand View Board of the County of Bayfield do ordain as follows:

Section I. Applicability and Enforcement

- (a) The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to the waters of Jackson Lake.
- (b) This chapter shall be enforced by the Officers of the Township of Grandview, the County of Bayfield, and the State of Wisconsin.

Section II Intent

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the wildlife native to this area, and also to allow for the enjoyment of aquatic recreational activity consistent with the public rights and interests.

Section III State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted

State boating laws as found in ss. 30.50 to 30.71, Wis. Stats., are adopted by reference.

Section IV Definitions

- (a) "Slow-no-wake" means that speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steering control.
- (b) The area covered by this ordinance is in two (2) townships. The north edge of the channel is located in the Township of Grand View and the south edge of the channel is located in the Township of Namakagon.

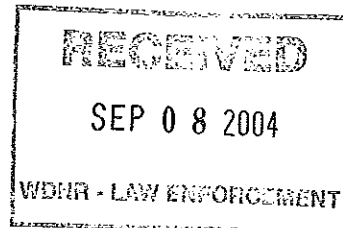
Section V Controlled Area
