AN ORDINANCE TO DELETE AND RECREATE SECTION 20.08 OF THE CODE OF GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF BURLINGTON RELATING TO SPEED LIMITS AND RACING.

The Town Board of the Town of Burlington, Racine County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 20.08 of the Code of General Ordinances of the Town of Burlington, Racine County, Wisconsin, is hereby deleted and recreated as follows:

20.08 SPEED LIMITS AND RACING

- (1) No person shall operate a motorboat on Browns Lake or Bohners Lake in a contest of speed or maneuverability unless such contest or competition is authorized by the Town.
- (2) No person shall operate any boat powered by an engine, or any other boat in or upon the waters of Browns Lake at a speed in excess of 50 mph. between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and sunset on any day of the week or upon the waters of Bohners Lake at a speed in excess of 40 mph between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on any day of the week.
- (3) The speed limits set forth in (2) shall not apply to police patrol boats in situations involving emergencies, or while engaged in law enforcement, or to boats participating in a duly authorized race, regatta or water ski meet duly authorized by permit while operating in the designated area authorized by said permit nor to water safety patrol boats in situations involving emergencies.
- (4) All motorboats travelling in exess of slow-no-wake speed, must be operated in a counter-clockwise direction on Bohners Lake.
