ORDINANCE #1997-1

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE #1-1984 REGULATING
WATER TRAFFIC, BOATING AND WATER SPORTS UPON THE WATERS
OF THE TOWN OF SPRINGWATER AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES
FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Springwater, Waushara County, Wisconsin, did enact Ordinance #1-1984 regulating water traffic, boating and water sports upon the waters of the Town of Springwater, Waushara County, Wisconsin, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board reserved the right to adopt additional traffic rules as it deems necessary in the interest of public safety in SECTION IX. TRAFFIC RULES, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board now believes there to be a need to regulate the flow of boat traffic in a certain manner in the interest of public safety.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT Section VII. RESTRICTIONS SPECIFIC TO PARTICULAR WATERS LOCATED IN THE TOWN OF SPRINGWATER, Paragraph (a) GILBERT LAKE, sub-paragraph (4); Paragraph
(b) KUSEL LAKE, sub-paragraph (4); Paragraph (c) PINE LAKE, subparagraph (4); Paragraph (d) ROUND LAKE, sub-paragraph (4); and
Paragraph (f) WILSON LAKE, sub-paragraph (4) of the aforementioned ordinance #1-1984 be created to read as follows:

(4) Direction of Boat Traffic

It shall be unlawful for any person to water ski, surf board or participate in a similar activity or to operate a water craft pulling a skier, skiers, surf board or similar device at any time except in a counter clockwise direction.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Ordinance #1996-5 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

In all other respects, Ordinance #1-1984 is hereby republished, ratified and confirmed.
