Amendment

An ordinance to regulate water traffic, boating and water sports upon the waters of that portion of Lake Alice and the Wisconsin River, within the town's boundaries and jurisdiction which are located 300 feet north and 300 feet south of the County Highway "A" bridge; and prescribing penalties for violation thereof.

The Town Board of the Town of King, Lincoln County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1 - INTENT - The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest, and water resource capability.

SECTION II - APPLICABILITY AND ENFORCEMENT - Provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of that portion, of Lake Alice and the Wisconsin River lying 300 feet north and south of the County Highway "A" bridge of this town and shall be enforced by court, town officers, together with any and all state and county officers authorized by law to enforce the same.

> SECTION III - STATE BOATING AND SAFETY LAWS ADOPTION - Wisconsin Statutes, Section30.50 through 30.71, inclusive, are adopted by reference.

> SECTION IV - DEFINITION - "Slow-no-wake" means that speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control.

> SECTION V - CONTROLLED AREAS - All slow-no-wake areas shall be designated by buoys meeting the Wisconsin Administrative Code standards, NR 5.09. The slow-no-wake area shall be located 300 feet north and 300 feet south of the Wisconsin River bridge on County Highway "A" , Town of King, Lincoln County, Wisconsin.

> SECTION VI - PENALTIES - For penalty range, Wisconsin Statutes 30.80 is incorporated herein by reference. / A specific bond scheduled may be adopted as part of this ordinance or by separate ordinance.) A specific bond Schedule Should be applicable only to those penaltys not covered by the State bond Schedule,

SECTION VII - <u>SEVERABILITY</u> - Each provision of this ordinance is severable, and if any provision is held unlawful or unconstitutional, the remaining portions shall survive and be in full force and effect.
