INTENT & SYNOPSIS: AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A SWIMMING AREA PURSUANT TO

SECTION 30.77(2) OF THE WISCONSIN STATUTES:

WHEREAS: The Adams County Board of Supervisors of Adams County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish a swimming area and provide safe and enjoyable aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interest and the capability of the water resource.

Section 2. Applicability and Enforcement. The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of Lake Camelot within the jurisdiction of Adams County. The provisions of this ordinance shall be enforced by law enforcement personnel within Adams County.

Section 3. State boating and Water Safety Laws Adopted. The statutory provisions describing and defining regulations with respect to water traffic, boats, boating and related water activities and safety found in the following enumerated section of the Wisconsin Statutes are hereby adopted and by reference made a part of this ordinance.

30.68(7) Restricted Areas

Section 4. Area Designated. The area designated as a swimming area shall be as follows: Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 16, Town 20 North, Range 6 East, Town of Rome, Adams County, Wisconsin, extending 125 feet along Adams County property shoreline, at a distance no greater than 125 feet into the water.

Section 5. Penalty Section. The above shall be in strict conformity with Section 30.80 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
